

Minutes of Baronial business meeting, held October 27th, 2002

The meeting was called to order at 6:02pm, 19 in attendance.

The usual order was changed to accommodate attendee schedules, and we first heard from Dame Aislynn regarding Lady and the Tiger. She needs help at 8am for setup, and after 10pm for cleanup. Also, she would like dedicated servers. Ursula will have loaner garb onsite by 10:30 or 11am.

Seneschal: Belphoebe will run the November meeting, due to Miles' schedule. Their Majesties will be at Lady and the Tiger. It is a great opportunity to showcase our barony!

Exchequer: We have \$3,330.87 in our account. The quarterly report has been delivered. Attendees voted to advance \$500 to the head cook for Lady and the Tiger for food purchase. Also, she will write a check to cash for \$100 for troll seed money. We will discuss the Ponte Alto financial policy at our January business meeting.

MoAS: Scriptorium is now held at Shrevewood Elementary School, sched-

uled on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of each month at 7pm. Due to the holidays. however, there will be no Scriptorium the 4th Thursday of November or December. Enter the A&S competition at Lady and the Tiger.

Chronicler: Il Tempo will be posted on the Baronial website beginning with the November issue. Need any submissions for that issue asap!

Knight Marshall: Thursday night heavy fighter practices are done for the winter. We now have our week-night practices on Wednesdays in conjunction with Stierbach. Contact Kevin for details. His Majesty will be head marshall at Lady and the Tiger, and will need at least 3 warranted marshals to assist him. By the next Baronial birthday, Kevin will be stepping down from his position as Baronial Knight Marshall. He will ask Marcellus to take over that job. His deputy Duncan will be warranted by then and can marshall for heavy fighting. Kevin will still be available to assist in marshalling from time to time.

Rapier Marshall: Lord Thomas Lyon has his warrant as a Rapier Marshall. Ponte Alto rapier fighters had a good showing at Kingdom Crusades.

Archery Marshall: not present.

Chatelaine: Lady Luce has her warrant as Chatelaine. There will be a newcomers' table at Lady and the Tiger. The next newcomers' meeting will be November 8th at Miles' and Luce's new home.

MoL: not present.

Herald: Heraldry happens.

His Excellency: At Kingdom Crusades, our rapier fighters kicked serious butt, but our heavy fighters were not so fortunate. 7-8 armored Ponte Alto fighters in tabards were present. We progress as a unit. There will be changes to the structure of the Marshallate. In future there will be 3 levels: Senior, Junior, and Marshall-in-Training.

Old Business: nothing.

New Business: Lady Celia reports that St. Paul's Lutheran Church (where we hold our business meetings) has expressed interest in having us come for an A&S type demo sometime in January or February. They would like to see Harp & Drum, Alle Psalite, some dance, possibly other things.

Upcoming events in the Barony:

1. Baronial Birthday/Performers' Revel, Feb 22, 2003, will probably be at Anne and Tirloch's church. There will be some classes, a small feast. after the feast the event will probably become a demo, with a performance in the evening open to all. It MAY become a Royal progress; His Majesty MAY teach one of the classes. We will (probably) select our Baronial Bard and Artisan at this event. Since it is a dry site, we will not be able to select our Baronial Brewer at this event.

- 2. Bloodbath, March, 2003. We need an autocrat, Miles will ask for "volunteers" shortly.
- 3. Tourney of the Cups (Working event title), September, 2003. Stierbach says yes we may host the event at Prince William Park. Luce will work to get that site; will be looking for volunteers beginning in January.

Crown Tournament November 1st-3rd, 2002 Kingdom of Atlantia/Barony of Bright Hills - Street, MD

The Barony of the Bright Hills invites all of Atlantia to join us in celebrating the Crown Tourney of their majesties, Cuan & Padraigin. The Tourney will be held November 1st - 3rd, at Rocks 4H Camp, near Belair, MD. In addition to the traditional tournament and pagentry, other activities such as archery, childrens programs, and of course, shopping will be available.

His Majesty plans a Curia prior to feast on Saturday.

The Bright Hills cooks guild is planning two separate feasts. The 3 remove, above the salt feast will be limited to 104 seats. The below the salt feast is planned for 50 gentles (plus or minus) and will be served al fresco, weather permitting.

A separate childrens dinner and party will be held from 6pm to 10pm. Belated trick-or-treating is planned, so bring that left over candy. Childrens programs are not a baby sitting service. Parents are expected to sign children in and out and to donate a minimum of one-half-hour of their time. Unsupervised children found playing in the stream, or too near the list field, will be taken to heralds point and their parents summoned.

The camp offers plenty of space for tent camping, or cinder block dorms which have showers and flush toilets. Bunk space is available on a first come first serve basis. A block of 20 rooms has been reserved at the Best Western Inn, at the intersection of I-95 and Route 24 for \$60/night. Rooms must be reserved prior to 10/13/02 to ensure the special price. Persons needing handicapped accessible rooms can request them at the discount rate, however, there are only a few available. Call the Best Western at 800-408-4748 and ask for the SCA special rate.

Generous parking is available near the camp entrance, and at the dorms.

From the Capital Beltway (495): Take Exit 54 A/B (Braddock Road), going West. Go approximately 5.6 miles to Ox Road (Rt. 123). Turn Left on Ox Road and go approximately 2.1 miles to Burke Center Parkway. Turn Right onto Burke Center Parkway, and go approximately .1 miles to Fairview Woods Drive, and then turn left. Enter into the church parking lot on your left.

Follow the Parkway about 7 miles to the light at Dumfries Road. Turn left and follow Dumfries Road (south) approximately three miles to the fair grounds on your left.

From Richmond, VA and Points South and East: Take I 95 north to Virginia Route 234 north (Exit 152). Follow Virginia Route 234/Prince William Parkway approximately 15 miles to the light at Dumfries Road. Turn right and follow Dumfries Road (south) approximately three miles to the fair grounds on your left.
