

Unto the populace of Ponte Alto greetings,

Well it is August and Pennsic is here once again. I would like to take this time to thank everyone who has worked so hard throughout the year to get our baronial encampment ready. Your hard work has made it possible for so many to enjoy the special moment that is Pennsic. I thank you very much.

I would also like to remind everyone that though Pennsic is special, we must remain vigilant about safety. These includes:

Ensure that we all drink plenty of liquids (water not just the other kind). Do not leave valuables out in the open. Watch for who is in our camp. Be courteous, but do ask them why they are here. No one should walk alone at night, especially ladies. If a Lady must go out after dark I would ask the Lords of our Barony to ensure that she is escorted.

Lastly, a reminder about nominations for Baron and Baroness. It is required by our Baronial Charter that all nominees for Baron and Baroness except their nominations in writing. If you are nominated, I must receive your acceptance in writing no later than the next business meeting after you were nominated. For you, that will be prior to the September meeting. I have included the relevant section of our charter below for your review. I am also available as always if you have any questions.

From the Baronial Charter:

"Candidates may be self-nominated or nominated by another person.

All nominations must be made at a Barony meeting designated for that purpose. Potential candidates must accept nomination in writing. If a potential candidate is not present at the meeting where he/she is nominated, the seneschal shall inform them of their nomination. The candidate(s) must accept nomination by the next meeting. Persons nominated to serve as a couple must agree to do so. All candidates must agree in writing to the provisions for term of office and selection of successors, and pledge to maintain them."

I hope to see you all at Pennsic and as always thank you for making my job so much easier.

Marshall, Heavy: Check your armor and check the rules so you'll be up to date at Pennsic. One new rule is that a directed face touch is now considered a "kill". Please be kind and chivalrous to your fellow fighters. Congratulations to Lord Duncan the Elder, who is now a fully warranted heavy fighter marshall for the barony.

Marshall, Rapier: Rapier is picking up this summer, we have 4 new rapier fighters (all ladies!). The Atlantian 5-'man' rapier melee is now scheduled for Monday August 11 from 3 to 5 pm. Our rapier fighters are looking forward to Chalice of the Sun God and to Coronation in September.

Marshall, Archer: Marshall not present, but it is reported that Catalina del Aqua is now a warranted combar archer for the barony.

MoL: No events, so no news, but Agnes will be helping as a MoL at Pennsic.
