From the West (in MD): Take the best route to Rt. 32 East to I-97 South. From I-97 take Exit 5 Rt. 178/Crownsville. At the light off Rt. 32, Rt. 178 goes straight and also goes off to the left. Continue straight on Rt. 178 South for approximately 1.8 miles. At the light turn right onto Crownsville Road. Continue for approximately .9 miles and turn right onto Hawkins Road. There will also be a sign for Elks Camp Barrett. Continue for approx 1.8 miles. At the bottom of the hill, go straight through the stop sign to enter the camp.


