

Coronations, English Style

In the last millennium England's Westminster Abbey has witnessed thirty-eight coronations: the first documented coronation was that of William the Conqueror on Christmas Day 1066, and the most recent was Elizabeth II on 2 June 1953.

Before 1066 most coronations had been held at Bath, Winchester, Canterbury, and Kingston-Upon-Thames. The order of service written by St Dunstan, once Archbishop of Canterbury, for the coronation of King Edgar in 973 has formed the basis of all coronation services since.

Only two Sovereigns have not been crowned in the Abbey: Edward V, one of the Princes in the Tower who 'disappeared', and Edward VIII who abdicated in 1936 before his coronation.

Willam The Conqueror - Confusion Leads to a Riot

After defeating Harold at the Battle of Hastings, William the Conqueror came to the Abbey for his coronation, but it did not run smoothly.

It was attended by both French-speaking Normans and English-speaking Saxons. As the congregation shouted their approval in both languages, the Norman soldiers, trying to keep order outside, thought the noise inside was an assassination attempt and began setting fire to the houses surrounding the Abbey. Smoke filled the church, the congregation fled and riots broke out outside! Meanwhile, inside the Abbey, William and the officiating clergy completed the service, despite the chaos.

Henry III - A New Westminster Abbey

Henry III succeeded to the throne in 1216. London was under the control of France so instead of Westminster, nine-year-old Henry was crowned King in Gloucester Cathedral. It was 3 years later, that he was officially crowned and anointed in Westminster Abbey.

Henry was a very religious man and his favourite saint, Edward the Confessor, founded the original Abbey in 1065. He believed St Edward (who was buried in the Abbey) deserved a grander resting place. So he began rebuilding the Abbey, seeking inspiration from cathedrals in France. He intended it to be a burial place for him and his successors, and a site for all future coronations. By incorporating into his design a large central crossing in front of the High Altar he created a huge space for the coronation 'theatre', where the crowning ceremonies have taken place ever since.

Edward I - The Coronation Chair

When Henry III died in 1272 he was succeeded by his son, Edward I. He captured the Stone of Scone from the Scots in 1296 and had an oak chair made to contain the sacred Stone. The Coronation Chair is on display in the Abbey and the Stone, returned to Scotland in 1996, is now on display at Edinburgh Castle.

Richard II - A Procession from the Tower of London

Richard II was crowned in the Abbey in 1377. The day before his coronation Richard processed on horseback from the Tower of London to Westminster. The procession passed through London streets bustling with entertainers and decorated with bright banners and tapestries.

His was the first ever coronation procession, and thereafter monarchs (until Charles II) continued this tradition, sometimes resulting in huge celebratory pageants along the route.

Mary I refuses to be Crowned on the Coronation Chair

Queen Mary was crowned in Westminster Abbey in 1553. She succeeded her brother Edward VI when he died aged 15 years. A Roman Catholic, she refused to be crowned sitting on the Coronation Chair because her Protestant brother Edward had previously been crowned on it. Instead she insisted on using another chair, blessed by the Pope, for the crowning and the Coronation Chair was used as the throne.

Queen Elizabeth I - The English Language is Introduced into the Coronation Service

Elizabeth I succeeded to the throne after the death of her sister Mary I. Her 1559 coronation marked a significant change in the service, with the introduction of the English language into the previously all Latin ceremony. Many bishops refused to attend her coronation and the Archbishop of Canterbury refused to crown her, so the Bishop of Carlisle did it instead.

King James I - The English & Scottish Thrones are Joined

When Elizabeth I died she left the throne to her cousin, King James VI of Scotland, son of Mary Queen of Scots. He came to London with Anne of Denmark, his consort, to be crowned James I of England in 1603. His coronation was very significant: it represented the uniting of the English and Scottish crowns, and he was the first Scottish King to be crowned sitting on the Stone of Scone (contained in the Coronation Chair) for over 300 years.
