


In honor of Chalice II: The Poseidon Adventure, we present...

Poseidon, God of the Seas

In Greek Mythology, Poseidon was the god of the sea, known to the Romans as Neptune, and to the Etruscans as Nethuns. He was also the god of earthquakes and horses.

Poseidon was a son of Cronus and Rhea. Like his brothers and sisters save Zeus, Poseidon was swallowed by his father. He was regurgitated only after Zeus forced Cronus to vomit up the infants he had eaten. Zeus and his brothers and sisters, along with the Hecatonchires, Gigantes and Cyclopes overthrew Cronus and the other Titans. According to other variants, Poseidon was raised by the Telchines on Rhodes, just as Zeus was raised by the Korybantes on Crete. When the world was divided in three. Zeus received the earth and sky, Hades the underworld and Poseidon the sea.



In the historical period, Poseidon was often referred to by the epithets Enosichthon, Seischthon and Ennosigaios, all meaning "earth-shaker" and referring to his role in causing earthquakes.

Poseidon was a major civic god of several cities: in Athens, he was second only to Athena in importance; while in Corinth and many cities of Magna Graecia he was the chief god of the polis.

Like Dionysus and the Maenads, Poseidon also caused certain forms of mental disturbance. One Hippocratic text says that he was blamed for certain types of epilepsy.

Sailors prayed to Poseidon for a safe voyage, sometimes drowning horses as a sacrifice.

When in a good mood, Poseidon created new islands and calm seas. When in a bad mood, he struck the ground with his trident and caused chaotic springs, earthquakes, drownings and shipwrecks.

In Memoriam - Sándor Vitez

On August 12, 2005, Ponte Alto lost one of its own: Sándor Vitez (mka Alan Wormser) suffered a stroke from which he did not recover. Sándor only joined Ponte Alto about a year ago, but in that short time, he touched the lives of many.

One of Sándor's first appearances in Ponte Alto was a dance practice held over the summer of 2004 at Tyson's Pimmit Park. He was only Alan then, as Sándor had not yet been discovered, but clearly dance was a point of entry for him into the SCA. He spoke of his folk dancing experience, and was eager to add new dances to his repertoire. A year later, Sándor was preparing to take over the dance practices he so gladly attended, to give our previous dance leader more time to spend with her newborn child.

Most of Alan's folk dancing background involved Eastern European dances. His interest in his own Hungarian heritage clearly motivated his research in that area, moving beyond dance into the choosing of an appropriate SCA name.

The shared skill of fleet feet between rapier and dance makes the two activities a natural mix, and soon Sándor was attending fencing practices as well. He had authorized in rapier in May 2005, and was looking forward to playing at Pennsic 34, which was to be his first Pennsic.

But Sándor could not come to fight at Pennsic. Instead, the Barony of Ponte Alto came, and fought in his name.

The heavy fighters of the Barony mustered at the Atlantian pavilion on the battlefield on Monday of war week, as black ribbons bearing a gold S, the colors of Ponte Alto, were bestowed on those who wished to honor Sándor's memory on the field of battle. Rapier fighters also sported the ribbons in their bouts, as well as any gentle who wished to show their support.

Sándor Vitez may not have been able to attend Pennsic in body, but we are certain he was there with us in spirit.
