## the Real Middle-Ages

## Newcomer's Pennsic Expectation

What can a new person expect at Pennsic? Pennsic is like other SCA events, except it's like it bloomed overnight on miracle grow, into a whole different experience. One is immersed in an environment different than ordinary life. Like other SCA events, there is heavy fighting, rapier, archery, classes, merchants, bardics, and dancing, except by over 10,000 people on a square mile of camp ground.

As far as you can see, there are tents, many of them period. Everyone is dressed in garb. The heavy, rapier, and archery go on day after day. There are more classes in a day than an SCA university, and for many days straight. There are more merchants than you can shop at in a day in almost city district like streets. At night, there are many parties, sing-a-longs, dancing, and bardies.

Many people stay at Pennsic in camps. If you are in the Barony of Ponte Alto, you are welcome to camp with the barony. Some people camp with their household. You can camp as single camping, in your own small camp. If you are going to stay in a hotel, make a reservation early, so you don't have to commute from Pittsburg.

Pennsic runs July 24 – August 9, 2009. The barony camp, as with most other camps, require that you pre-reg with Pennsic and select us as your camp. The deadline to pre-reg online (http://www.pennsicwar.org/) is June 15 (and by mail May 15). You must select the camp exactly as spelled, for instance, "**Barony of Ponte Alto**". I, Mark McGroyne, mka Marlin Pierce, am the land agent for the Ponte Alto camp. For the barony camp, you must also go to the Ponte Alto web site (http://pontealto.atlantia.sca.org/pennsic/) and register there.

For heavy fighting, siege, and rapier, you must be authorized BEFORE going to Pennsic. Pennsic is in a different Kingdom, and you will not be able to authorize there. For archery, all you need is to have your bow inspected, which you can do there.

Now for preparing for Pennsic. There is information on the Ponte Alto web site some of which may be useful if you are camping with your household, including a packing list.

First, think that you are camping, where the rule is, if you didn't bring it, you may not have it. Now stop thinking that you are camping, because it's not camping. First, you are not hiking where you have to limit your supplies to what you can carry. You are driving up, and can bring all the creature comforts you can fit in your car. For instance, a (small) bed!

Then there's plenty of opportunity to buy things there. It's said with unlimited money, you could go to Pennsic with one outfit of garb, and buy everything you need there. Although, who has that kind of money, you can be confident that anything you forget or don't want to bring will be available.

You do not need garb for every day you are there. There is a small coin laundry on site, but it may be more practical to drive into town if you need to do wash. If your SCA wardrobe is limited, you may plan to

enhance it there. If it is your first time, you will discover things you urgently need, like a hat or belt pouch.

There are food merchants, and a small produce store. You could buy all your food there. The Ponte Alto camp will have a food plan that you could join. You may want to bring some non-perishables, or make trips to town for fresh food. I recommend focusing on bringing snack food, as you may discover that is what you really needed a lot of.

Of course, bring a tent, period or modern. There are various bathing facilities. The Ponte Alto camp, as most camps, has a camp shower. You might bring shade, as there may not be trees where you are camping. In the Ponte Alto camp, Fighters may not take off armor in the common area, so think about bringing a stool for your personal area.

Once you get to Pennsic, you first register at troll. You need photo ID, proof of membership in the SCA or you don't get the SCA discount (the Acorn mailing label works), the remaining site fee, and you will need to give your license plate number. If you do not know your license plate number, write it down.

There will be a map in the center of the book they give you at troll. The camp ground is two miles north-south, and half a mile east-west. There is a lake in the middle. North of the lake is a tree-less area where most of Pennsic happens, merchants, fighting, archery, classes. As the SCA is on a continuum between the strict civil war re-enactors and the ren faire, the people who camp south of the lake are the less strict about authenticity, the SCA society, and maintaining a family oriented environment.
