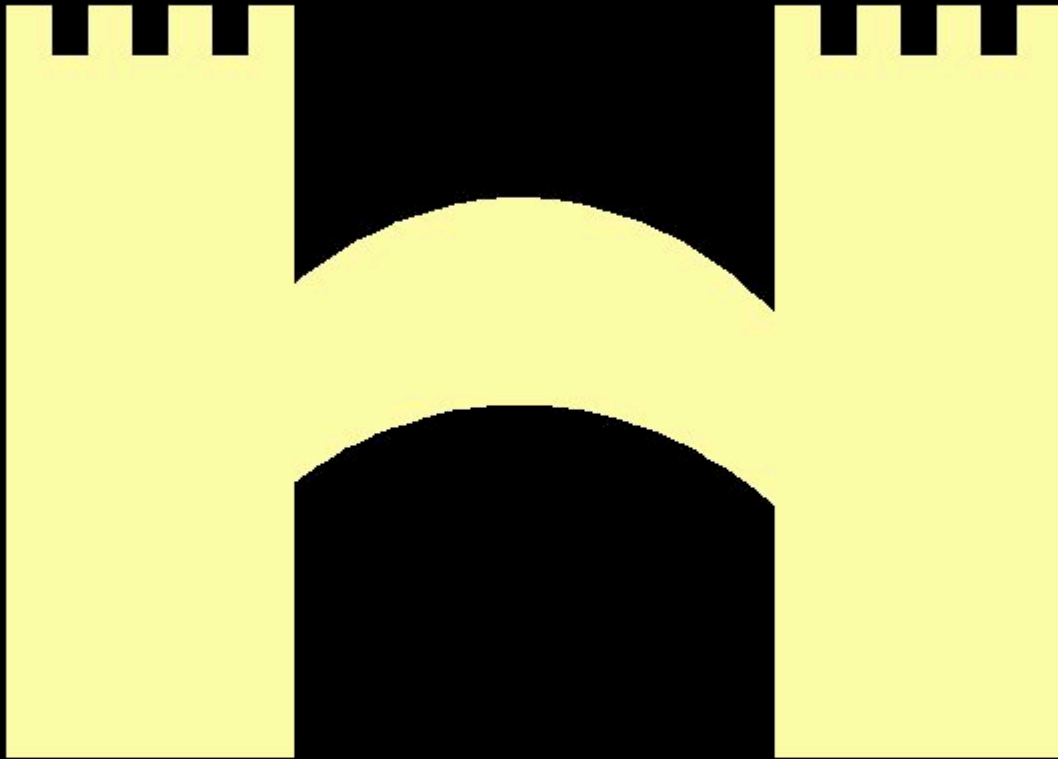

# Baronial Business Meeting Minutes

Meeting — July 25, 2010-6:01 p.m.

## OFFICER'S REPORTS

**Seneschal-** Baron Marcellus Capozziello da Napoli: Marcellus thanked everyone for coming. Then mentioned the fact that the SCA Board of Directors met this past week and Countess Denise was in attendance as an officer. It was hoped that she would be at the baronial meeting to tell us something of what went on, but she was not. Moving on, as everyone knows Baron James and Baroness Katharine will not be taking up another term, and the Seneschal having solicited for Letters of Intent received two before the Baronial Business Meeting: one from Lady Sian and the other from Lord Drogo and Lady Adina. A third candidate will be needed before the polling can be made official. It was also pointed out at Curia that the term limit for Baronial Candidates had been extended from 2 years with a vote of confidence for an extra year, to 3 years with a vote of confidence adding 2 additional years onto the Baronial term. Also, on the subject of Curia, Mistress Ann who attended was able to tell us/clarify issues as they popped up. Marcellus mentioned we might be able to have the weekend in February usually reserved for University for Bloody Investiture, because it and Kingdom Art's and Sciences had flipped dates, but Mistress Ann was able to clarify the reason for the date switch. Although we got our hopes up, and are still hoping for a happy resolution for the date of our Baronial Investiture, the date switch was so that their highnesses could be at KASF. Their highnesses/future majesties want to be able to attend KASF and encourage the Art and Sciences, which is not a No Conflict weekend for us to run our event against. That said they had already planned to attend KASF as a show of encouragement for this venue. However, Marcellus is still talking to Kingdom about the dates, i.e., our feelers are still out and the submission of event dates may be reconsidered. Also, it was brought up while discussing Curia and the up coming Polling, that in future, Pollings of Confidence would be at the whim of their Majesties, and could be either an official mail-out Polling or a general call around to the Baronial populace to get an idea of the Baronial representatives competency and popularity.

**Exchequer-** Baroness Celia of Rosedale: There is \$12,160.45 in the Baronial bank account. The storage unit has been paid for through the end of the year, and an increase of \$10 was noted at this time. The Exchequer mentioned that she had thought about looking for another unit but also pointed out at this time of year the unit's price tends to go up, and for a ground level unit we were getting a pretty good deal already. So she is holding off looking for another unit until a later date. Also, the second quarter report is done and waiting for the Seneschal's review and signature, after which it will be sent to Kingdom.

**Knight Marshals-** Charles the Bull: Not in attendance. Marcellus gave the Knight Marshal's report. The Saturday Pre-Pennsic Melee event hosted by Lord Lucas had a good attendance of 10 fighters. The Field Marshal for the day was Baroness Marie-Therese Normand and the fighting was paced but fiercely fought. Everyone remained hydrated and there were no injuries.

**Rapier Marshal-** Lord Geoffrey ap Clywd: Not in attendance. Marcellus gave the Rapier Marshal's report. Fencing practice is continuing. The fencers are doing lots of melee practice in preparation for Pennsic, and there are 4 war points Pennsic is designating for the Rapier field this year.

**Archery Marshal-** Lord Miles de Locwode: Practices continue with 3-5 people in attendance. Pennsic is allowing Archers to shoot twice for Tuesday/Wednesday (i.e., you can shoot twice on Tuesday or twice on Wednesday or you can shoot once on Tuesday and once on Wednesday for the populace shoot.) Thursday and Friday are champion shoots and limited to those chosen. Champion's shoot/battle are included in the points. Oh and we are aligned with the East. At the moment we are the only Kingdom aligned with the East.



**Arts & Science-** Mistress Belphoebe de Givet: A&S throughout the Barony continues to happen all over the place. However, the most important thing is that her deputy Bevin will be stepping up to the office of A&S officer. They have sent out for the warrant. Mistress Yasult, had been contacted and they are expecting her warrant at any time. Then she expressed her thanks to Bevin for volunteering. Ending her report with, "You rock!"

**Chatelaine-** Lady Emma West: Not in attendance. Baroness Katharine gave the report as the last newcomers meeting was held at her home with 21 people in attendance and three brand new people finding their way to the meeting. It was definitely a success since it went very late.

**Herald-** Lady Sian verch Gwilim ap Lewelin: Came in late. Lady Caitilin Irruis inghean ui Riada gave a preliminary report about her son's heraldry and reported that the herald was working on his device and name and it should be at Kingdom in the July batch of considerations. Then the herald came in and gave her report later in the evening. The Herald said nothing was actually happening. Several submissions had gone around the kingdom and are going through at different levels a couple past local, kingdom, and are almost at Society level.

**MOL-** Position not filled: However, it's not a necessary position for the Barony. Also, Cassandra is now an MOL at large.

**Chronicler-** Baroness Marie-Therese Normand: This month's issue of the Il Tempo is going to be light because of Pennsic. There will be no game and no article, but other than that articles and art are still needed. This publication is not just about me, its about the Barony so even if you feel shy put in something you feel strongly about, want to research, or want to get across to your friends.

**Web Minister-** Giovanna Rossellini di Firenze: She reported that the Website is not something that goes through big changes each month, so she is keeping up. She also informed the populace that the Chalice of the Sun God page is open. On it you will find this year's blurb to inspire the artisans, a list of past champions per event, a FAQ, and a team sign up form should be live or coming very soon.

#### BARON AND BARONESS

Pennsic is coming up. Hopefully the weather will be the same as last year.

Baron/Baroness: Opening Ceremony: the B&B would like to meet the populace at the Baronial encampment and walk over to the East Kingdom encampment together. Baroness Katharine would especially like more than four people to walk with them in line to show numbers in support of the Barony and Kingdom. Also, the day and time of our Baronial court at Pennsic was restated as Tuesday at 7:30 and the new Baronial Brewer will be picked at that time.

In October, War of the Wings will be happening and we will be supporting Stierbach by fighting, doing A&S, bardic, and anything else we can get points for.

#### EVENT

**Pennsic-**Is less than 5 days away and counting down. Our land is in the same place as last year, on block N31. If you are traveling to Pennsic and you think you have room please tell the land-ocrats (Katharine, Brigid or Aislynn) as they will need help getting some things up to the Pennsic site.



If you travel to Pennsic the first week please help set up, or at the end of the event help take down. Other than that, Marlin's here to give cash to the Camp head from last year overage.

**Chalice of the Sun God-** There was a little issue this morning with paperwork. The budget this year is close to last year's. The site fee went up from \$1,140 to \$1,200. Basically it will be as close to last years as possible with the exception of the site fee. There was only one copy of the event budget, so the seneschal looked at it and roll-called the budget for voting. The total requested was \$2,200; this included \$190 equipment fee, \$650 feast with a 60 person feast in mind, \$1,200 site fee, \$70 print publication fee, \$150 for supplies. It made the breakdown for individual's site fee \$11 adult \$6 child /\$8 adult \$6 child. The break-even number is 115-140 people with the expectation of 120-160 attendees. The feast to person and individuals ratio didn't sound right. So, some numbers were crunched and a feast of \$410 for 60 people was agreed upon, because it was scaled-down percentage-wise from last year's larger 100 person hall to the 60 percent of last year's budget, since 60 percent of site space all we were going to use. Changing feast expenses to \$410/drops the total fee \$240 for feast. Marcellus crunched more numbers and the total for the event budget came out to \$2,070, which dropped the break even point to 110 people. The budget was voted on and passed as it was modified by all present.

Then it was confirmed that Sophia was doing the feast, Lord Gustav was MIC, and Alric the Mad would free up Marcellus to participate in the Rapier tournament by being the Rapier MIC.
