Baronial Business Meeting Minutes

Meeting — September 26, 2010-6:00 p.m.

OFFICER'S REPORTS

Seneschal- Baron Marcellus Capoziello da Napoli: Welcome. Last barony meeting before we are buried in events. He's put in the request for polling labels; they should be coming shortly. He then announced the need to put in a monetary request for stamps, envelopes, and paper of \$400, with \$100 dedicated to printing. Katharine volunteered her printer and envelopes to the cause reducing expenditures by \$100. Luce asked for a vote on \$300, it was seconded, and a vote was immediately called for to designate \$300 dollars to the polling effort for supplies and was passed unanimously. Luce asked about the estimated number of members and was told the Seneschal would not know that until the labels came in. And then a general time line of the labels receipt and mailing were outlined reiterating that they would have to go out fast since the labels were only good for two weeks.

The question was asked by Baroness Emma when those outside the baronial lands would get their polling or could write in and make comments to the crown on their preferred candidates. The Seneschal answered the first or second week in October. If you are not a member of the barony living inside the baronial lands, and do not receive a polling letter by then, you can send a letter in at that time.

Exchequer- Baroness Celia of Rosedale: \$9,920.00 is the current balance. She paid a couple of site fees. All of Chalice's site fees are paid off and the deposit for half of Crown's site fee is paid.

Knight Marshal- Charles the Bull: N/A. (Marcellus) Last week was the first week the heavy fighters moved back into the school (Lemon Road Elementary). They will be there barring school functions and cancellations until next summer on Thursday Nights.

Rapier Marshal- Lord Geoffrey ap Clywd: Back in the school (Shreve Road Elementary).

Archery Marshal- Lord Miles de Locwode: - (Luce) Archery has not yet moved inside but will be very soon. Someone asked if they would be back at Bull Run? And Luce answered, that she believes so.

Arts &Science- Lady Bevin an Broc Drannach: N/A. Marcellus confirmed that Bevin is now officially the MoAS officer.

Chatelaine- Baroness Emma West: The newcomers meeting was at their Excellency's house in September. They hosted 20 people, with four newcomers in attendance. The next meeting will be at Pippa and Edward's on October 15, 2010.

Herald- Lady Sian verch Gwilim ap Lewelin: All quiet on the front. Located James' paperwork and will get that approved tonight. Giovanna's paperwork is in the same moving mess as James' but has yet to be found. She is still working diligently on that.

Lady Caitilin Irruis inghen ui Riada mentioned that her device got bounced because of similarities in its description to another device that was being resubmitted for approval. The other person had precedence because it is a resubmit, but the heralds are trying to reach the person to see if a conflict is okay. So her device is in limbo right now.

Chronicler- Baroness Marie-Therese Normand: Introduced the fact that I would need a more up to date version of PDF because of the photos that would be used and the size of the files that would entail in future issues. Funding for this was dismissed when many people volunteered their PDF programs for use when needed. Also, asked for illustrations and stories and warned people that I

Also, one of the things the Baron and Baroness wanted to do before leaving office was to try and make certain everyone in the Barony was on the Order of Precedence (OP). Baroness Katharine then asked, "If you are not listed on the OP or you have an awards that is not listed please contact the Web Master immediately and CC them on the email."

Also, Pippa got her Golden Dolphin at Storvik Baronial Investiture and Giovanna got her AOA.

The other thing is, fight in Crown Tourney. The Baroness would like to see a good contingent on Pontoons in Crown Tourney.

EVENT

Chalice of the Sun God- Wulfwyn could not be at the meeting. Sophia read the following two emails as one letter to the populace:

After the pewter class at MS yesterday, I spoke with Chris Cunning about making tokens and he said it should be no problem. I'm covering the cost so there will be no cost to the Barony. I've sending him the information this week for what I want.

I'll be contacting Don's John's tomorrow to reserve the port-o-johns.

I'll be calling Bel later in the week to keep her up to date.

In addition...

Gustav stopped by the site on his way home, but could not see the site as it was being used this weekend. I'm going to call the main office and see if we can get the fire gate opened for the archers so they don't have to carry their equipment all the way down to the field. I'll have to have an additional parking attendant to direct traffic to that area. I'll also get directions for the archers to reach the fire gate.

Luce commented on the field set up noting that if that were so "then we won't need port-a-johns for the site." This being because it would allow the archers to have access to indoor plumbing. Someone else asked, "Do we have someone to bring list fences?" The Seneschal answered in tandom with the Crown Autocrat so the answer came across as a mish-mash of, "Sian is covering that since Bill will be out of town during the event." And "Friday night is when she is expect to deliver the list fence." With regards to the list fence and its site set up, three different arrangements have been considered for the list field/site set up. It's been pared down to the favorite two. And will be decided on closer to the event.

Also, Sophia is at the meeting to collect a check to cover the food expenses for Chalice of the Sun God.

Crown Tourney- The contract and payments for the site have been sent in to Loudoun County Fairgrounds. We have use of the site from 4pm Friday night to Midnight on Saturday. Normally we mop the floor as part of our cleanup routine, but the site gets someone to come in and do that anyway, so all we are required to do is sweep as a necessary part of our clean up routine

Form for Don's-Johns will be reviewed after the meeting. The only major volunteer issue is to get someone to take a lead on parking. Then volunteers will be routed out through that person with regards to parking. Originally tasting was scheduled for next weekend now it needs to be moved to sometime midweek since the Autocrat is required to go to Coronation.

Friday, the Autocrat sent out the announcement to the Merry Rose. We were assured that Giovanni was finishing up the website. And Oct. 30 is the last day to get ACCEP's to register you for the event. This is because of the time it takes to get reservation money through the banks and create a list for us to use at the gate. Giovanna was asked to include that by Celia. If there is anything else that needs to be made known to the public send it to Giovanni via email and copy Brennain on the information.

Meet Us Under the Bridge - The deposit has been sent in to the Moose lodge. A Co-coordination in the guise of Connor Sinclair has been confirmed via the grapevine to help with event back-up and guidance by way of Courtney's verbal ok to Baroness Katharine. And the event did make the Acorn this past month, but only a small little blurb, not the full info, but next month we will have the full flyer in the Acorn.

Also, it will put in the announcement a request for games to be donated for the events gaming corner, and to contact Marcellus for follow-up information, with the same type of request for the bardic entertainment to contact Bel with regards to bardic questions.

The autocrat contacted Char about the kitchen situation (we're only allowed to heat food on site, not to cook from scratch on site) and after Char's initial panic attack, she was assured that Luce's kitchen, very close by, was at her disposal.

Ponte Alto Baronial Investiture/Kingdom Arts and Science Festival – The site we wanted is not open Feb 5th. But the Love and Beauty site (Loudon Co Fairgrounds) is. Jan 22 and March 5 are two dates the primary site is open to us and falls within past dates we've discussed. The Crown requested that University and KASF be flipped so they would not have to conflict with other events

and so they would only have to make one trip north. Jan 22 is a no conflict date so far. It was decided to go for Jan 22 so we can get the primary site we want early in the year.

St. Paddy's Day Bloodbath - Giovanna cannot autocrat Bloodbath. So it will need a new autocrat. Marie-Therese waffled on volunteering because she couldn't remember her calendar, so Anya decided to do it. This event is at Nottoway Park on Courthouse Road and is a pretty easy event to host because it is all fighting all day and only a small luncheon to contend with. Due to the fact that it is so small the only things to worry about are the marshals, and how many you can get to marshal rather than fight.

Archery Event- We now have an autocrat in Baroness Emma.

OLD BUSINESS

Coronets - Baroness Katharine sent Master Lothar at Drakenstein another email.

Hosting Kingdom Archery - Baroness Emma volunteered to autocrat. Just need a date for KA.
