# Baronial Business Meeting Minutes

January 23, 2011

## 6:00 p.m.

## OFFICER'S REPORTS

Seneschal - Baron Marcellus Capoziello da Napoli

Welcomed the newcomers and regular Ponte Alto meeting participants. Congratulated the new Baron and Baroness of Ponte Alto (Drogo Rainulf de Dragonera and Adina Von Der Heide). He thanked the last Baron and Baroness (Master James Biblesworth and Baroness Katharine Devereaux) for their service to the Barony. Then thanked everyone for their service in helping pull off a wonderful event With all the thanks and congratulations extended, the Seneschal moved onto address the issues of the New Year and reminded those gathered that Quarterly Reports were due by the 15th and, in some cases, the 30th of the month. He encouraged those officers that had not gotten around to doing their reports to do so.

## Exchequer - Baroness Celia of Rosedale

A review of the books done every two years by Kingdom was expedited last week; Ponte Alto's books balanced and are in good shape.

The Chamberlain's warrant was mentioned by the Exchequer at this point but will be addressed in the Chamberlain's section of the minutes.

The Exchequer informed us that the Baronial Financial Policy will have to be amended to reflect that the Seneschal and Exchequer must be members of the Financial Committee in order to be a part of the decision-making process. The Exchequer will give the Chronicler (Mary) a copy of the Financial Policy to be put in the newsletter for two months prior to the change made to give members of the Barony time to review the wording of the change.

A budget for 2011 was put together for the Barony of Ponte Alto to better understand and allot funds for the coming year. The Exchequer does not have to do this but thought it would be a good idea so that members could see how funds are being spent and perhaps allot funds for specific things. A budget for 2011 was discussed item-by-item; the final total was initially asked to be put to vote, but was put off until February's meeting so that the budget could be published and the populace could review it.

Storage is about \$1,575 a year or a few dollars more since there is normally an increase around June/July when units are at a premium.

The church meeting room costs \$180 a year (at \$15 dollars a night; we added an extra day with the early December meeting which we normally don't have).

The Exchequer proposed and added an expense for officers using their own money and working on tight funds of \$100 dollars a year.

Coronet Upkeep of \$100 for cleaning and repair of the very fragile Baronial Coronets.

The total Budget for the upkeep of the Barony is \$1,955.00

Celia, our current Exchequer, is looking to transfer of office to Daniel Warwick in the next few months (March/April). She will serve as Deputy for the office, but asks for others to volunteer as Deputy.

The Barony has \$11,261.94 currently in our bank account. This does not include yesterday's event but does include the site fee for St. Paddy's Day Bloodbath and the Public Storage unit for the next 6 months.

It was asked if we could get a discount if we paid for the storage unit for the entire year. The Exchequer replied that she could check on it but it never seemed to make a difference paying in bulk in the past. She simply does it so as not to write checks every month, but she will check into it.

Chamberlaine - Lady Sian verch Gwilim ap Lewelin, not in attendance

(Celia reported)The Chamberlain has been doing this job for 5 years now and since her warrant is coming up for renewal she would like someone else to take over this job.

Knight Marshal - Charles the Bull, not in attendance

He is going to hand off staffs to the marshals.

Duncan, Cunian, and Helga gave reports on the Mock Tourney they organized. The Tourney was well attended with 10 fighters participating in the double elimination/bear pit. It was held outdoors and the quality of the fighting was on par with a real tournament. Sir Tash won the double elimination and Sir Justus won the bear pit tournament. Duncan then turned in the money for the next month's tournament to the Exchequer. He also returned a blank check that was accidentally mailed with the check for the Sunday school site (the blank check was stuck to the payment check). We have all the money necessary for next month's Sunday tournament practice. The school will also be closed either the week before the tournament Sunday practice or the week after. Duncan was encouraged to send out a email confirming which day practice would be held.

Many of our heavy marshal's have let their training or membership lapse; we have a need for them to take training. This can be done over the phone with a Kingdom-Level trainer. Kevin of Thornbury has promised to give Duncan the required training over phone and he will follow up in the coming week when Kevin is back in town.

Was talking with Luce and Brigid; he doesn't usually get to practice at Bull Run because he works in Fredericksburg. Fort Belvoir, however, is an option with a 20-yard indoor range and possible 60-yard outdoor range with 24-hour lighting and about a mile trail for bow use. Civilians would have to pay a \$75 fee for a years use and enter through Tully Gate; it seems that it's okay for civilians to once again use the range. He needs to talk to the Autocrat for Chalice of the Sun God since he is apparently running the shoot.

## EVENT

**Chalice of the Sun God** – An autocrat was solicited. This is a large event and needs a wellseasoned autocrat to carry it off. (See Lucas' Melee Event for further information.)

**Ponte Alto 20 Year (2012)** has been spiked for February 25, 2012. Master Tirloch has offered the Kena Temple and the thought is to rent one third of the ballroom (closest to the kitchen) and the kitchen. The question was raised by Mistress Cunian as to what would happen to Tournament of Love and Beauty and would there be a Tourney at the event? The site is not conducive to it. There's an Elks Lodge on Route 50 but the ambiance is lacking but it has a huge field at its back that might be good for fighting in February. It's worth looking in to.

**Unevent** – (SCA administrative meeting) Inquires have been put out to do this event in Ponte Alto. Luther Jackson Middle School, if Marcellus reads the rules correctly, won't charge us a site fee if we don't, in any way, make money off of it. AND there is enough commerce within walking distance to let SCAers to hunt down their own lunches.

Lucas' Melee Event – Lucas brought up something that he and Brennain are in the process of putting together at Prince William Campground on October 21-23, 2011. It's a melee event with Brennain doing a meat-heavy-styled feast. The ground fire rule has changed and are being allowed now. This will be an all day Warlord tourney. The weather will be nice and cool. The general consensus was to wait and see. Then it was asked how this event would conflict with Chalice, which is normally held in September or October. The idea to piggy back this event with Chalice was offered and the idea took hold as a really cool draw for an already established event. Since we normally have to be off site by noon, we would have to reserve the camps for all day Sunday. Camp 1 and 4, the discussed sites, unfortunately, close sometime in October so the dates are rather important to establish. These camps also include lots of parking. When no one stepped forward to land-o-crat, the Baron said he would do the job of land agent for Sapphire.

The Baron asked about the Badge for the Onore del Ponte d'Argento. The Herald has not yet passed this name and it is believed Sian is working on this. The funny thing is one of the awards has a badge and no name, the other has a name but no badge.

The Seneschal called for anything else and Christine Menton and Emma West asked if we could vote to go through and chuck anything unnecessary and too far gone to use in the Loaner Garb. The answer was "Yes, absolutely. You don't need to ask permission or get a vote to do so."

Although we did vote to appease Thomas of Calais' need to (in fun) oppose a vote.

Also, a similar question was raised about three tubs of silent auction items not sold that has been hanging around for a while. It was decided that it be up to the discretion of the one handling the stuff. Since it is all donated, it was suggested that it be taken to Salvation Army; we cannot get a receipt to use it as a tax write off.

The subject of new storage containers was brought up because ours are getting kind of beat up and unwieldy. The Exchequer wanted to have a vote, but it was put off until the next meeting as the Seneschal wanted the issue researched a little more thoroughly. Baroness Adina mentioned the clear ones get brittle in cold weather. Then it was suggested we get label-able ones. Celia will do research and make a motion for a vote at the next meeting.

# Variation on Miniature Plum Puddings

## **Contributed by Alesia**

This was served for 12th night, the year when Winifred was the head cook.

2/3 cup butter	1 cup finely ground bread crumbs
2/3 cup brown sugar (1/3)	2/3 cup half-and-half
¼ tsp. salt	1 beaten egg
¼ tsp. mace	1 cup raisins
1/8 tsp. cinnamon	2/3 cup currants
1/8 tsp. cloves	2/3 cup chopped dates

Combine first six ingredients in a large bowl, mix well. Add egg and half-and-half, stir well. Mix in breadcrumbs, stirring well. Combine raisins and other fruit; add to butter/breadcrumb mixture, stirring well. Spoon mixture into a greased <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> quart steam pudding mold; cover tightly. Place mold on shallow rack in deep kettle. Fill with boiling water a least an inch deep. Cover kettle and steam 3(?) hours adding water as needed. Let pudding stand.


Cook's Notes:

- 1. Combining a couple of tablespoons of the 1 cup breadcrumbs to the fruit helps breakup the fruit and prevents clumps.
- 2. Variation on fruit: 2/3 cup raisins, 2/3 cup currants, 2/3 cup chopped dates, 1/3 cup chopped orange flavored prunes (the PLUMS in plum pudding!)
- 3. This says a 3 cup mold but the ingredients add up to more than 3 cups. This may be two 3 cup molds rather than one.
- 4. Any metal container that can stand heat and water can be used as a mold. I have heard of people using the old metal coffee cans. You can use a spray to grease the mold. It works better on those that have lots of nooks and crannies. Do seal the top tightly with aluminum foil; I use a double thickness and crimp the edges very carefully. But remember some of these were cooked by putting them in a buttered cloth bag and popping the bag into the kettle boiled pudding instead of steamed pudding.
