May 22, 2011 — 6:05 p.m.

OFFICER'S REPORTS

Seneschal - Baron Marcellus Capoziello da Napoli

There will be a Full Curia 10:00 a.m. on Saturday at Sapphire Joust.

The Proposal for the Great Book of Law and changes to Symbols of Rank will be discussed there. Feedback for this discussion should be posted to the <u>feedback@atlantia.sca.org</u>. Crown Tourney had a short curia where they passed out handouts that have the wording of the proposed changes for the Symbols of Rank section of the Great Book of Law and a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) sheet for the discussion.

Exchequer - Baroness Celia of Rosedale

We have a balance of \$12,333.97 in the Baronial account. An emergency vote was taken for a site deposit for the Kena Temple in the amount of \$1,000.

For the Chamberlain's office an inventory was done and the Exchequer found the supplies were increasing due to silent auction items. The Exchequer proposed that anything that does not sell with the next auction will go to a thrift store (the items have been put out at three auctions). No objections were voiced.

Knight Marshal - Charles the Bull

The practices are getting better with regards to the heavy fighters. The last two Thursday night practices have had 10 to 12 fighters in armor. At the last practice, Count Vlad sparred with those brave enough to step forward with pole weapons. An average practice turnout for us is anywhere from 6 to 8 fighters now.

We continue to have good solid fighter practice; 2 to 4 youth fighters show up on a regular basis

The tassel she learned was for cleaning the arrows that got lodged in the ground or dirty. The arrow was then dragged through the tassel to clean it. Naran and Margaret attended as well.

Sapphire Joust coming up and a spreadsheet of those pre-registered should be posted on the web soon.

At Highland River Melees, there will be beverages/fighting/fighting/and more fighting, so come out and enjoy the event in support of our Barony.

June we may have an addition to our group, Allen, as our court jester. She lives in the Springfield area.

Spears and fighter practices are picking up. This week we did spear practice and last weekend Anglesey showed up and we had a productive melee practice. So come get your spear on!

EVENT

Kingdom Archery Championship

Targets are painted and backs are being finished. We will not be doing scorecards like at Crescent Guard Games. "BamBam", the post driver, and some other things need to be acquired. After the shoot is finished and results tallied, Court will take place (around 6:00 p.m.). We are expecting at least 60 archers. An e-mail out to the applicable mailing lists. Their Majesties are not expected to be there due to schedule conflicts.

Pennsic

Fourteen thousand people are expected and 28 more groups have registered this year. The Pennsic Committee is waiting to find out if SCA will approve fireworks. Paid parking will open the Sunday of opening week—it is usually sold out by Monday. On the Pennsylvania Turnpike near New Stanton, the gas station has only diesel gas. Be aware of that fact and plan accordingly.

Second week- Sophia will arrange and cook the meal plan.

The Baron and Baroness are planning court for Thursday at 5:00 p.m. unless the schedule is rearranged with Atlantian Court.

Chalice of the Sun God

The bid was incomplete; fee has been paid and forms for the site have been resubmitted.

Ponte Alto 20 Year (2012)

We went back to Kena Temple and have talked to them about Martial activities on site. They do not want martial arts activity there. It is difficult to get something over there with any type of martial arts activities because the HOA for the area has to approve the activity. We have put a deposit down for the site. The budget break out is \$12 for the site and \$10 for the feast. The Autocrat will be using ACCEPS, which he has tentatively decided will close two weeks prior to the event to get the feast numbers solidified. Merchants will not be charged for being on-site but may be asked for a donation for the Kingdom Travel Fund. Help with the decoration of the hall will be needed. Tokens for the event are being discussed with Kinaburh and Christopher Cunning (a bridge design with maybe two eyelets so that the token can hang on a hood or cord.) We have already acknowledged that we will take a hit on this event and have planned for it. Elizabeth of Hadley Hall is doing an Italian feast and it had been decided that anyone under 5 will eat free; anyone 5 to 17 years of age is \$10. And the Autocrat plans to get an ABC license so the site will be wet. We will be able to get into the site that morning. However, we are trying to get the access the night before—it is wholly dependant on the site's use. We need to vote on the budget for this event. But before we could the autocrat said he was going to raise the total number of members to 200 and Troll advance to \$100 since that worked for Crown.

The hall will need to be set up in stages and the tables for high table have been planned to be arrayed in a U shape. Kingdom Curia

At Sapphire Joust, Their Majesties Michael and Seonaid held the third Curia of Their Reign. A number of topics were discussed (see the Baron and Baroness' letter on page 1). During the Curia, they presented a letter to the populace for Their assembled Baronage to disseminate. The letter, below, addresses the Symbols of Rank proposal.

A letter from Their Majesties unto the Populace of Atlantia Concerning Symbols of Rank

Unto the noble populace of Atlantia do Michael and Seonaid, King and Queen of Atlantia, send greetings on this 27th day of May, 2011.

At Our Curia held at Crown Tournament on May 7, 2011, We announced Our intent to publish a proposal for codified Symbols of Rank. All present were directed to share this information and provide feedback on this proposal to Us at a dedicated e-mail address, which was created to ensure that commentary could be easily read and referenced, without getting lost in email forums.

Since that time We have received a great deal of commentary, some of it very polite, thoughtful, and constructive. However, We have watched with concern as a great many uniformed, disrespectful and blatantly rude comments have been sent to both public and private forums.

Based on some recurring comments, it has become clear that there has been a failure to adequately explain the purpose of these Symbols to the populace as a whole.

The purpose of these symbols is not to restrict but to define the basic style of both Viscounty and Baronial coronets, as the Laurel King of Arms instructed the Kingdoms to do many years ago. There is no reserved symbol for either Viscounts or Barons at the Society level. **There is a common misconception that a coronet of 6 points or pearls is the "Society standard" for baronial coronets. However, this standard simply does not exist, except in certain Kingdoms.** In 1984, Master Wilhelm von Schlüssel, Laurel King of Arms, explained his reasoning for not allowing barons to append their arms with coronets, and directed individual kingdoms to regulate both Viscounty coronets and Baronial circlets (his words). Only a few Kingdoms followed through with setting a defined symbol for either Viscounts or Barons, and in the intervening time, and lacking defined symbols of their own, the general populace simply followed along with what other Kingdoms allowed. Some have asked why we need these symbols now, when we have come 30 years without them. Atlantia has 17 baronies, with an average turnover in leadership every 3.5 years. Typically, retired territorial baronage become court barons/baronesses upon successfully completing their terms. Additionally, several court baronetcies are awarded each reign at the discretion of the monarchs. In practice, this means that the most common coronet worn in Atlantia, and very probably in all of the SCA, is baronial. Yet in some kingdoms, including Atlantia, there is little, if any, guidance as to the style those coronets should take. While creativity and personal taste should allow for a variety of different looks, as is the case with county and ducal coronets, having a reserved symbol creates a mark of distinction. Additionally, when educating newcomers to the SCA or to our Kingdom, it allows us to include the basic style in educational materials, such as Master Bran's excellent "Guide to Atlantian Heraldry", or to describe these coronets in a consistent way.

Although these particular symbols may not have been defined in the past, reserved symbols of rank are nothing new. The College of Heralds has reserved symbols of rank for various awards, orders and achievements for many years, such as white belts for Chivalry, laurel wreaths for Laurels, strawberry leaves for Dukes/Duchesses. Additionally, all Atlantian awards and orders have reserved symbols, such as the Golden Dolphin, Coral Branch, Sea Dragon, etc. Defined symbols of rank are how we identify the various achievements within the SCA. Court Baronetcies alone, among all awards and honors that may be bestowed within the Kingdom of Atlantia, have no such symbol. *(continued on next page)* Since its inception, the SCA has struggled to find balance between being more historical and being more accessible. We are not of the same ilk as many of the more historically accurate reenactment groups, yet we do distinguish ourselves from the common Ren Faire. Our feet are firmly in both camps, and this is good for the health of the organization. Although the SCA has grown toward greater authenticity over time, we are still a modern organization with a great many anachronisms, and trying to find balance is challenging. The awards and orders bestowed across the SCA and in Atlantia bear little or no resemblance to period achievements, but they are essential to the recognition and encouragement of our populace. When defining any symbol, it is likely it will not be period to the time or place of each individual who may be permitted its display. Thankfully there are a great many artisans whose knowledge and talent can be helpful in creating something appropriate.

We have been reading the feedback sent so far, and have already found some areas worthy of reconsideration. Some wording may be changed to be less confusing and accurately reflect the intent. This proposal is a work in progress, and we look forward to more, hopefully polite, comments from Our populace. We would like to address a few common misinterpretations here, and encourage you to read the full proposal and FAQ on the Atlantian website.

- We are aware of both the financial and sentimental value associated with coronets. There is indeed a "grandfather clause". We are investigating how best to express this in the law or an appendix, as appropriate. The Society grandfather clause referenced in the FAQ and in Master Wilhelm's letter addresses those who move from one Kingdom to another. We will also grandfather those coronets which existed prior to the enactment of the law. Although some may choose to alter their coronets to meet the definition, alteration is not required.
- Many of our Baronies have unique coronets which reflect the character of the Barony. It is Our intent to keep these unique qualities, and will seek to adjust the wording accordingly.
- The wording regarding "smoothly concave" will be removed as it is confusing. The intent is to state that the total number of points shall not be exceeded by having two heights of points. Just as with Ducal and County coronets, having a definition does not require a uniform style. We will seek to adjust the wording to allow for creative interpretation, while still achieving a definition.
- The proposal currently states that Territorial Baronial coronets (current landed baronage) may only contain laurels leaves if they are used as part of the Baronial arms.
- As ours is a society of honor, and many existing coronets already fall within the intended definition, we do not foresee that enforcement will be an area of great concern. Courtesy should be paramount. That is not to say that there will be no enforcement. Recourse does exist in the form of Courts of Courtesy, and other sanctions are available for those who persistently or egregiously refuse to follow any of the laws of our Kingdom or Society.

We hope this missive will help to address some concerns, and look forward to your continued feedback. Feedback should be sent to feedback@atlantia.sca.org so ensure it will be read.
