

## Summer Event Season Tips

#### Also known as: how to avoid bugs, sunburn, and stressful camping or day trips!

Chronicler's Note: my Deputy Lady Béibhinn and I crowdsourced this article in order to get tips to help newcomers AND long-time SCAdians.

#### Tents/Cabins

- ⇒ Always practice putting up a new tent before the event; you might arrive after dark and have to erect it then.
- $\Rightarrow$  Canvas only provides the illusion of privacy.
- ⇒ Make sure you can stand up in your tent; dressing in garb in a cramped space might sour you on camping events.
- ⇒ Toss a doormat, small rug, or towel just inside your tent or cabin. You can leave your boots/shoes there and not make a mess on the floor.
- ⇒ Bring a small or whisk broom and dustpan to sweep dirt from your cabin floor.
- $\Rightarrow\,$  Use a shower curtain liner to cover cabin mattresses, then put your sleeping bag or bedding on top of that.
- $\Rightarrow$  Buy an inexpensive sheet to cover your table, camp stove, chairs at night. It will help with keeping the dew off your things.

#### First Aid/Personal Stuff

- $\Rightarrow\,$  Always have insect repellant (for mosquitoes AND ticks) and sunscreen handy.
- $\Rightarrow$  Learn to identify snakes!
- $\Rightarrow$  Hydrate—even if you think you don't need it; remember to eat when it's hot
- $\Rightarrow$  Put your clothing in waterproof bags or in water-proof tubs.
- $\Rightarrow$  Always check your boots/shoes, bags, bedding. Local critters might have moved in while you were out for the day.



⇒ Keep treasured possessions (including money) secure. Theft, while unimaginable for most of us, does happen in the SCA. (continued on next page)

## Summer Event Season Tips (continued)

#### <u>Packing</u>

- ⇒ The Known World Handbook has a great packing list for camping; other online sources are good for regional considerations.
- $\Rightarrow$  Pack food in a plastic bin or other enclosed container.
- $\Rightarrow$  Bring an extra blanket—even in July. Nighttime temperatures often feel colder than they sound.
- ⇒ Pack a complete change of clothes in a bag and leave it in your car. It will come in handy at rainy events. Pack it in a trash bag so you'll have something to take your trash home in if necessary. Bring extra socks—for cold AND warm weather
- $\Rightarrow$  Pack your tent and day shade in the car last. That way, you can easily pull it out and set them up, having a place to stick your gear.
- $\Rightarrow$  Bring a car charger for your phone. Have a flashlight for camp (don't leave candles unattended, especially if fire danger is a concern).
- $\Rightarrow$  Put a cloak or blanket between your sleeping bag and the air mattress/bunk.
- $\Rightarrow$  Pen and paper for writing down names and addresses of your new friends.

#### With Kids

- $\Rightarrow$  Have healthy snacks and drinks on hand, even if feast is offered.
- ⇒ Precook what you can and reheat onsite.
- $\Rightarrow$  Bring books, games, coloring, etc. (even if they aren't period).
- ⇒ Have car chargers for handheld electronics.



- ⇒ Bring an MP3 player with Iullabies or classical music. It covers much of the "after hours", fireside noise when kids are trying to get to sleep.
- ⇒ In hot weather, have a spray bottle filled with cool to cold water to spritz on kids. A rectangular piece of linen, soaked in cool water, is also good to cool off children.
- ⇒ Small Glo-lights or Chem-lites are great to put on a string and tie to a child's wrist or wear as a necklace (ages 5 and up). This way, you can find them in the dark. They also makes a good nightlights.


