Officer Reports

Seneschal: Lady Marie-Therese Normand

- Not present

Exchequer: Lady Melissent d'Artois

- Melissent stepped up as Exchequer at Symposium
- Lady Katharine Devereaux remains on as deputy.
- Katerina (Tracy) has stepped up as Chamberlain.
- The Barony made \$377.36 at Symposium from troll and lunch.
- The baronial account has about \$8000
- Anyone may contact Melissent for an appointment to see the baronial account books if they so desire.
- With the stepping up of a new Exchequer, a review of the books by the Kingdom Exchequer is supposed to occur, date TBD.

Heavy Marshal: Lord Duncan the Elder

- Practices continue, weather permitting - Some practices have turned into video nights at Lord Cosimo's apartment instead, including an especially good spear video for those interested.
- Reminder that there will be a northern regional practice at the regular Sunday practice on 3/27/05

Rapier Marshal: Lord Geoffrey ap Clywd

- Eight Ponte Alto fencers participated at Ymir, with 3 new authorizations, Cwenhild, Guiliana and Hatteras.
- Ponte Alto capelets from storage will be given to the rapier marshal for distribution to the newly authorized fighters.

- The Northern Atlantian Army (Stierbach and parts north) has had a lot of turnover, so there are a lot of newer, less experienced fighters that need training.

- Most staff is in place, but still looking for an MOL for the rapier list and assistance with setup, troll, and cleanup. Please contact the autocrat if you can help!
- The flier finally made it into the Acorn and three reservations have already been received!
- The Barony voted unanimously to donate all profits from the event to the American Diabetes Association
- The Barony also voted unanimously to provide a jar at Troll to accept donations for the travel fund of TRH Robert and Denise.
- The Barony will also accept donations to TRH Travel Fund prior to the event; please make checks payable to The Barony of Ponte Alto, SCA Inc. and send to the Baronial Exchequer.
- Please bring a jug of water to Bloodbath, as water is not readily available on site.
- Lunch will be hot soup, bread and cheese.

Chalice: September 16-18, 2005

Siobhan, autocrat; Lady Luce Antony Venus, deputy autocrat

- New byline: The Posiedon Adventure (if the weather won't come to us, we'll go to the weather). Based on Homer's Odyssey
- Siobhan will be autocrat, as Luce and Miles are expecting the arrival of John Richard in June. Luce will be deputy, and have most stuff setup by May.
- As the autocrat is our Baronial MoM, a MoM for the event is needed.
- A new Parking Czar is also needed.
- Marsaili will take the lead on the Silent Auction



- The Chalice concept: Chalice Champions in each discipline (heavy, rapier, archery, artisan, bard) defend their titles against the winners of each challenger competition. Teams fielded in at least 4 of the 5 disciplines compete for the Chalice of the Sun God.
- The site will probably be Prince William Forest Park again: wet site, cabin camping only; no tents
- A request to have Saturday breakfast again was made

Pennsic: August 2005

- A newcomer, Laura, has agreed to be Ponte Alto's Land Agent. Arnfridr will be the Camp Registrar, and Nick will be the Camp Steward.
- Lady Perronelle la peintre will continue to assist, and she and Laura will get the Barony registered as an encampment this week.
- Lord Robert of Calais has the shower pieces to be collected
- Baroness Belpheobe asks that you please contact her if you are planning to camp with the Barony at Pennsic so they can have a rough head count
- Guidelines from last year apply, including the 75 sq. ft. common area set aside per camper and calculations of 3 extra feet per tent side for tents without ropes and 6 for tents with ropes.
- Preregister by June 1, 2005 to allocate your space in the Baronial encampment. If you have not preregistered with the Barony, you are not guaranteed space within the Baronial encampment

November Event: November 2005

- No ideas for a November event have come forward as of yet
- Baron Marcellus asked if we want to consider hosting Crown Tournament in November instead of the usual November event
- Issues of sites within the Barony were brought up, and a suggestion to resurrect the site committee (although not by the mother-to-be Luce) was made
- Other suggestions included trying to host University in June 2006

Old Business

- Travel thrones are in the design stage. Master Ranulf of Waterford is working on the design and has offered to donate leather for the seats and backs.
- Storage Unit: Baron Marcellus was appalled at the way Baronial stuff was crammed into the existing 5' x 5' storage unit and how everything has to come out to get at what you need. The existing thrones will not fit in the current storage unit. The 5' x 5' unit in Herndon is currently \$50/month, but that rate raises again in June to \$54/month (making our Exchequer unhappy) The Exchequer will direct the new Chamberlain to search for new storage space (5' x 10'). It was suggested that we attempt to use our 501(c) status to cut a deal, if possible.
- Happy Birthday, Ponte Alto! Ponte Alto turns 13 on 2/28 or 3/1, 2005, whichever is deemed closer to the actual leap day birthday.
- Lady Perronelle la peintre brought forms to fill out for the Ponte Alto phone directory. An online submission form is possible, although there are a few security concerns.
