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

January 23, 2011

OFFICER'S REPORTS

Seneschal - Baron Marcellus Capoziello da Napoli

The Seneschal welcomed everyone. There's not a lot going on on the Seneschal's front. The Kingdom's newsletter will be produced electronically by January 2012. You can request a hardcopy; otherwise distribution will be via the Internet. And, SCA dues will be going up.

Exchequer - Baroness Celia of Rosedale

The Exchequer reported that our current balance is \$13,144.95. Investitures report is almost ready, except for a partial site deposit waiting to come back and be deposited (it was just handed to her). She estimates that the event made somewhere in the range of \$375 to \$400 dollars profit. Her Doomsday report is done and submitted to Kingdom; our Baronial net worth increased by roughly \$100 this year to \$14,080.91. The Budget did not make it into the *II Tempo* this past month because the Exchequer had a lot going on with her life and it was forgotten. She assured the populace it would be in this month's issue.

The Seneschals and Baronial Representatives were there to analyze the Northern events and a few things came out of it. One issue was that the North (anything north of Stierbach) doesn't get a lot of the Northern events. Some of this is due to the site requirements and the length of time needed to reserve a site; some is due to the lack of Northern sites. For example, William Baron of Storvik says they must reserve Croome Park the day it opens for booking; it's totally booked up by noon of that same day. Also, Kingdom is trying to change the

bid process so that the participants in crown tourney already know where Crown and Coronation will be should they win. This gives everyone time to participate and anticipate the travel requirements. Currently Kingdom is taking bids for Fall Crown Tournament and Cornation.

The Baron and Baroness will be going to University and the other Baronial Investitures that are happening in March. The Baroness is asking for donations for gift baskets for these up coming events. The items should be given to the Baron and Baroness. They assured the populace gathered that they WOULD be at St Paddy's Day Bloodbath (it was left off their progress)!!

EVENT

St Paddy's Day Bloodbath – The Autocrat got a call asking if he could MIT at the event and the Heavy Marshal replied that he could. She then asked that Marshals volunteer for the event and was assured by the Heavy Marshal that we have Duncan the Elder, Baroness Marie-Therese, His Excellency of Caer Mear and three others to help with the heavy field; Charles the Bull and one other would be helping with the Rapier Field. They also asked about coordinating the list fence. Marcellus said he and Bill were working on that. Garb for the event was requested and a confirmation that it had been taken care of.

Kingdom Archery Championship – Emma presented a budget for the event which covered the site fee, food, toilets etc. She raised the food budget just in case extra people come through the door. Loudoun County Fairgrounds is only costing us \$660 because are just using the house. Marcellus motioned for a vote on the budget and Luce seconded the motion. It was voted on and the motion carried unanimously.

Chalice of the Sun God – The event is 'spiked' for October 21 to 23. The site, amazingly enough, is only \$875 thanks to Lucas' keen negotiation. This is for camps 1 and 4. The food is \$480, the pig roast \$250, the BBQ and Dons Jons are \$200. The budget was presented and if the event does as well as in prior years, we could cautiously expect to make \$1,000 dollars profit. Katharine wants to make a presentation in court of an invitation the scriptorium creates for Their Majesties. Their Highnesses will be presented an invitation at their Coronation. After discussion and budget explanation, Marcellus moved for a vote; Luce seconded the motion. It was voted on and the motion carried unanimously.

Unevent – Marcellus contacted Kingdom about the event and has yet to hear back from the point-of-contact. But, he checked out the school requirements and if no money passes into our hands and it's a free event then the site (Luther Jackson Middle School) would be ours for free. So we would not be doing a lunch but, like Day in the Middle East, we'd supply a list of restaurants within walking distance that could be good for lunch.

Ponte Alto 20 Year (2012) -Tierloch is working with Kena Temple to allow fighting at the site. But, they need to get Mantua Homeowners' Association to approve it. Luce says she will talk to them as someone at Mantua may be indebted to her or be in favor of giving her a break for our group. ACCEPS will be used for the event; Elizabeth of Hadley Hall will be Head Cook. Aslin will be games coordinator and there will be a "History of the Barony" display covering the past 20 years. There will be a "shortest time in history of a canton" contest, as well as heavy fighting coordinated by Mistress Cunian. Event planning is moving along nicely.

OLD BUSINESS

Coronets-No one has heard anything back about them, but we have the old ones back from being cleaned.

NEW BUSINESS

I introduced one of my new Deputy Editors, Lady Theresa O'Cahir (Theresa Crean).

Geoffrey the Rapier Marshal is requesting \$60 to buy youth-sized rapier hoods. The request was put to the populace, voted on and approved unanimously.

The storage bins were brought up. But it was tabled as research continues.

The new Poeta Atlantiae's poem about Her Majesty was so moving the King, who was judging the contest, asked others their opinion because of his bias where Her Majesty is concerned. It was only later that it was learned that the event was only Ettienne's third event! Vivat!!

The Barony of Ponte Alto Financial Policy

1. Ponte Alto Financial Policy

- a. Ponte Alto Financial Policy shall be accepted by a majority vote of the populace of the group and replace all previous financial policies and may be amended or replaced by a majority vote of the group.
- b. Ponte Alto Financial Policy shall be reviewed yearly.
- c. Ponte Alto Financial Policy is superseded in order by: Kingdom Exchequer Policy, Kingdom Financial policy, Kingdom Law, Society Exchequer Policy, Corpora, Commonwealth (state) and Federal law.

2. Financial Committee

- a. The Financial Committee
 - Defined as the Seneschal, Exchequer, and all paid members of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. who attends the Barony of Ponte Alto's business meeting.
 - ii. At business meetings all financial needs will be brought to the Financial Committee for voting purposes. A majority vote will allow the money to be spent. In the event of a tie, the vote shall be moved to the Emergency Financial Committee. The Financial Committee may allocate money only up to the amount that is currently in the General Fund and no greater.
 - iii. Business meetings are held the 4th Sunday of every month with possible exclusion of December. Meetings are publicized on the baronial website .Monthly reminders may also be sent by the Seneschal to the Baronial e-mail list
 - iv. A roster of paid members shall be kept by the Exchequer.
- b. The Emergency Financial Committee (ECF)
 - Emergencies are defined as money that needs to be spent before the next business meeting.
 - ii. This Committee shall consist of the Exchequer, the Seneschal, and a third officer whose position rotates on an annual basis each February The rotation shall be Knight Marshal, Minister of Arts and Sciences, Chatelaine, Herald, Minster of the Lists, Chronicler, and Web Minister. Each member of the Emergency Financial Committee must be a paid member of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc, be at least 18 years of age, and possess a valid warrant for their office.
 - iii. Members of the Emergency Financial Committee shall have one vote. Should a member recuse himself/herself from a vote in which there is a conflict of interest or appearance of impropriety, a Deputy Exchequer shall cast the third vote.
 - iv. Spending approval is permitted up to \$1,000 unless the allocation is for a site fee. Spending approval is permitted up to \$2,000 for a site fee.
 - v. Meeting of this Emergency Financial Committee may be in person, over the phone, or via e-mail.

vi. Financial decisions made by EFC are reported at the next monthly business meeting and recorded in the *Il Tempo*.

3. The Chancellor of the Exchequer

- a. The Exchequer shall maintain a checking account with appropriate signature cards for the group, file all annual, quarterly and event reports as required by Kingdom and Society law and policy, enforce and maintain the group's financial policy, serve as chairperson of the group's Emergency Financial Committee and hold primary responsibility for coordinating with other members of the Emergency Financial Committee, and communicating the committee's actions with the populace.
- b. The Exchequer shall, upon request, provide access to the group's financial reports and books to any member of the group. He/She and shall publish the annual Doomsday report in the local newsletter, with a copy sent to the Kingdom Chancellor of the Exchequer.
- c. The Exchequer shall pursue any NSF (non-sufficient funds) checks received by the group according to the policy outlined in the Chancellor of the Exchequer Local Officer's Reference Handbook.

4. Disbursement of Funds

- a. Signatories on all Baronial accounts must include the exchequer, deputy exchequer, and seneschal. Also regional deputy kingdom exchequer and Kingdome exchequer as per kingdom policy. Other signatories may be added as needed, i.e., additional baronial officer or deputy and ,emergency deputies of the kingdom exchequer
- b. Authorization for disbursement of funds.
 - For the routine expenses of meeting room rental, storage facility rental, and newsletter publication disbursement may be authorized by either the Seneschal or the Exchequer. The Exchequer shall report all such expenses at the Barony meeting following their disbursement.
 - ii. For all other expenses, authorization shall require a majority approval by the Financial Committee. Prior to voting, proof of membership will be required for those baronial members wishing to vote at the meeting, this includes the Baronial officers and the Baron and Baroness of Ponte Alto. The Exchequer shall verify membership before the vote.

5. Events

- a. The Autocrat shall present a written, itemized budget for an event to the Financial Committee 3 months prior to the event date, before any expenditure for the event is made, and before the event flyer has been published. The Barony may vote to waive this provision under exceptional circumstances (i.e., the Barony is asked to host a Kingdom event in less than 3 months.)
 - i. The budget may include provisions to waive gate and feast fees for sitting Majesties, Their Heirs, and the event's Head Cook.
 - ii. The budget may also include provisions to waive gate and feast fees for the event's Autocrat, Head Troll and Baronage of Ponte Alto.
- b. The Financial Committee must authorize any itemized expenditure in excess of the approved amount.
- c. Event reservations and check in (Troll):
 - i. All checks shall be deposited in a timely manner according to Kingdom policy.

ii. No funds shall be removed from the cash box except as change for funds received.

- d. The Exchequer must receive event-related receipts and requests for reimbursement no later than 5 business days after the event.
- e. Event refunds shall be provided as follows:
 - i. Feast refund may be provided if the feast spot was resold to another attendee. No refunds shall be provided if the event does not make a profit.
 - ii. The Exchequer must receive refund requests in writing no later than 5 business days after the event.
 - iii. All refunds shall be paid by check from the Barony's checking account.
 - iv. No refund shall be issued until the event books have been closed and all reservation checks have cleared.
- f. The event report is completed by the Exchequer within 2 weeks of the event. The event financial report shall be presented to the populace at the first regular business meeting of the group after the event books have been closed.
- g. Any photocopies of checks shall be shredded by the Exchequer after the books have been closed.

6. Special Funds

- a. Any funds raised for a specific purpose will be maintained as separately allocated fund for a period of 1 year from the time of establishment. After this time, if they have not been spent, they will be transferred to general funds or a vote may be taken to retain the fund. These funds will be maintained within the baronial checking account.
- b. The financial committee may authorize a special fund to be maintained without time limit until the purpose of the fund is no longer needed (i.e., maintaining funds for regalia/coronet until enough is raised for purchase).

The Exchequer must receive special fund-related receipts and requests for reimbursement within 60 days of purchase

From the SCA, Inc. Board of Directors

Due to external economic conditions and increased overall costs facing the SCA Inc., the Board of Directors and senior staff have been forced to make over \$250,000 in cost cutting measures to the 2011 budget in order to ensure continued operations.

The largest recurring expense for the SCA at the corporate level is the stipend payments made to the Kingdoms for publishing hardcopy newsletters. As our modern society moves increasingly away from hardcopy publishing to electronic mediums, the costs of hardcopy publishing have increased proportionally. Based on the need to curb these costs, and the responses of the membership in the 2010 census, the Board of Directors believes it is essential for the continued financial health of the SCA to transition the organization away from paper newsletters. Accordingly, the SCA has initiated a project to transition all kingdoms to enewsletters, and is projecting implementation by Jan 1, 2012. Until the SCA has the infrastructure in place to support e-newsletters, the 2011 stipend amount provided by the corporate level for production assistance will be reduced to cover only those aspects required by the governing documents. This will reduce the overall stipend for mailings and production by 60%. The decrease will begin with the stipend checks being mailed after the end of the 1st quarter of 2011. The Board of Directors greatly regrets the necessity of making these changes to the stipend structure, but feels that it is the best of an array of difficult options to execute its fiduciary responsibility to the membership of the organization.

This means that postage will still be covered for all mailing classes, including the expected postal rate increase later this year, but the production stipend will be greatly reduced. Most components of newsletter production costs are controlled at the Kingdom level, including newsletter size, use of color printing, page count due to non-required information, and printing companies utilized. Thus, Kingdom Chroniclers have several tools at their disposal to lessen the impact of the stipend decrease. To further mitigate the financial impact to the Kingdoms, the following changes in required inclusions will be effective with April 2011 newsletters:

- Membership forms will no longer be required to be published
- The list of Board of Director nominees will no longer be required to be published
- Full Society regnum will no longer be required to be published. Contact information for the Kingdom Ombudsman must still be included.
- A statement indicating where to locate the additional information on www.sca.org and/or Kingdom websites will be required to be published.

As additional reminders, branch event announcements are only required to be published for the month in which the event occurs. Should the branch event occur in the first week of the month, publication in only the prior month is acceptable. Please refer to the "Chronicler's Handbook" for the minimum event information required for publication.

The Society Chronicler has information available for the printing house in Knoxville, Tennessee (USA) that several Kingdoms have already been utilizing for more cost-effective printing and mailing services.

Fundraising that is specifically done for the purpose of newsletter publication is still allowed, but (as always) is at the discretion of the Kingdoms.

The Board of Directors, SCA, Inc. greatly appreciates the time and effort put into newsletters produced at all levels of the organization and is committed to implementing a financially responsible process to provide information to the membership by a blend of electronic and hardcopy media.

Senet

2 players

5 pieces each

The object is to bear your pieces off first.

This game uses four two-sided dice (white on one side and black on the other).

1 white up is 1

2 white up is 2

3 white up is 3

4 white up is 4


0 white up is 6

START

Players alternate throwing the dice until someone throws "1". This player is black, goes first, and moves his marker from 10 to 11. He continues throwing dice and moving the number indicated until 2 or 3 is thrown. He moves that number, and then passes the dice to his opponent.

MOVEMENT RULES

- If you land on your opponent, he is attacked and goes to the space you just left.
- ♦ 2 of the same color can't occupy the same square.
- 2 of the same color on consecutive spaces protect each other from attack.
- ♦ 3 of the same color on consecutive spaces form a blockade, your opponent can't attack or go past, but you can.
- ♦ Dice throw which can't be used to go forward must be used to go backward. You can't go back to the occupied square. If you can't do either, your turn ends.
- Space X is a trap. If you land here you must go back to the first empty space.
- ♦ Space ♀, III, II, and I are havens, you can't be attacked here.
- ♦ When all of a color is in the last row, you can bear off by landing exactly on I.
- ♦ You get one point for each enemy left on the last row except in the havens, two for each in the second row, and three for each in the first row.
