#### OFFICER'S REPORTS

## Seneschal -Baron Marcellus Capoziello da Napoli

New law and policy are online and the announcement for the new laws and policy are in the acorn. Kingdom is still making changes to Law and Policy but the 150 mile rule is now in effect.

Next weekend is Unevent, there will be no order meetings, just officer meetings. Where? S. Md. (Dun Carraig) It will be held at a church and for the first time ever we will be charged a \$5 fee for Unevent. This is to defray the site fee necessary for us to host the event.

Also, Marcellus is getting his warrant renewed for seneschal and we will have him for as long as the barony wants him.
