October 23, 2011 6:00p.m.

OFFICER'S REPORTS

Seneschal -Baron Marcellus Capoziello da Napoli

A few big things-

- The second batch of census data is out. Additional peerages are being discussed, the issue of same sex territorial baronages and Kingdom consorts was brought up and being discussed. So far the decision of baronages is strait forward. They can be held by two women or two men. The Kingdom consort issue is a little more difficult. Some Kingdoms have the issue built into their law and because the same sex of consorts is built into Corpora they are leaving it up to the Individual issues and if it is not written into Kingdom law it is allowable. Currently the issue of what types of abuses could happen?
- Unevent is going to be in MD about an hour away. No order meetings will be held. Majesties will meet with orders at various events, but not at Unevent. Site will cost \$6 fee per member to offset the total site fee of \$1,500.

Dun Carraig has spiked an event for 2nd week of March, which is our traditional weekend. However, with some discussion and checking other available weekends, it was decided to spike Bloodbath for the 24th of March, which will not conflict with any other event currently registered.

OLD BUSINESS

First Aid Kit, got it.

Plastic bins, 3 bins have somehow become 5 bins. Celia has a line on bins from Lowe's that are black and yellow. They're known as contractor bins with wheels. They are \$25 dollars apiece. Celia would like to have one for

women's clothes one for men's clothes and a smaller one for kids. She asking for \$75 for the purchase of bins. Marcellus offered the suggestion of \$75 for bins, Marie-Therese seconded the motion and the group voted on the issue. It passed with a unanimous show of hands. And the Motion carried.

Coronets, Adina Talked to Mimi about coronets. Mimi says they'll be \$200 apiece. Once we determine a design, she could have them completed in a month. If the design was a sectional plate design, the Plates would cost \$35 apiece (etched). She is currently working on a back piece to make it adjustable for different sizes. Adina showed Mimi the sumptuary laws for Atlantia at the consult to incorporate into the design plans. Suggestions are being solicited for the coronet design. She's put some thought into it, and the B&B sat and talked with her for an hour and a half about the project.

Chatelaine asked to print Business Cards for her office as representative of the Barony with SCA logo and such? She was told she could and Marcellus even has a template he'll send her.

Also Adina asked if anyone has ever had a populace favor? Black and gold fabric? Or bridge favors? Is there anything out there? Anyone want them? Suggestions were made, so everyone is seen and known to be a part of our Barony and not just one of the three Baronies in Atlantia that has yellow and black as their colors.


Tablut

History:

Tablut is a Finnish tafl game. A tafle game is one where the sides are unequal (in size or strength). This is a variation of the Norse game known as Hnefatafl



Play

In Tablut the two sides are known as the Attacker Side and the Defender Side (sometimes called the King Side).

It is played on a 9 square by 9 square board.

Playing pieces move orthogonally. (Vertically or horizontally, but not diagonally.)

The Attacker Side starts with 16 playing pieces (positioned in the above diagram as green pieces).

The Defender Side starts with 9 playing pieces (positioned in the above diagram as yellow pieces). There are 8 regular pieces and 1 King piece. (The King piece is marked in the above

diagram with a "+" symbol on it.

The center square of the board, called the King's Square is depicted as red in the above diagram.

The object of the Attacker Side is to capture the King, which is accomplished by surrounding the King on all four orthogonal sides, or surrounding the King on three sides with the center square of the board (the King's Square) being the fourth side, or if the King and another Defender piece are enclosed on all sides so that neither the King or the other Defender piece can move.

The object of the Defender Side is to move the King piece off the board.

Other playing pieces (of either side) can be captured by orthogonal interception. That is to say that the piece is "caught" between two opposing pieces, either two horizontally, two vertically, or one of each.

If a playing piece moves between two opposing pieces voluntarily, it is NOT captured.

If the move of a Defender piece (either regular playing piece or the King piece) gives the King piece a clear line of exit from the board, the Defender player must announce this.

If the King piece has two clear lines of escape from the board, the Defender must announce this also.

If a move of an Attacker piece gives the King piece a clear line of exit from the board, no announcement must be made (by either side).

The players take turns moving one piece, beginning with the Attacker Side.

The number of squares a piece may be moved is determined by the roll of one 6-sided die.


The number roll on the die is the maximum number of spaces a piece may move; fewer spaces may be moved if desired.

The number may NOT be split between pieces. Only one piece is moved per turn.

A piece can only move in one direction during a turn.
