Magna Carta Exhibit at Library of Congress

Lincoln Cathedral in England is loaning one of the only four surviving copies of the Magna Carta, issued in 1215. The document is the centerpiece of the new exhibit, :"Magna Carta: Muse and Mentor." The 10-week display opens November 6 and runs through January 19, 2015. The National Archives also holds a copy of Magna Carta from when it was reissued in 1297 under King Edward I. That document remains on long-term display.
