

## SCA's 50th Year Begins

May 1 begins the 50th year of the founding of the SCA. Unlike an infant who turns one 365 days after they are born, Anno Societatis (Latin for "in the year of the Society) begins each May 1st, the date of the First Tournament in 1966. It was held in Berkeley, California.

The origins of the Society for Creative Anachronism began with David Thewlis (now Duke Siegfried von Hoflichskeit) and Ken de Maiffe (now Duke Fulk de Wyvern) who, along with Diana Paxson (Countess Diana Listmaker) who were all

studying medieval history at University of California, Berkeley. They decided to hold a recreation of The Last Tournament in Diana's backyard and invited all of their friends. With everyone in medieval costume, they opened with a procession of knights and their ladies. Fighting was judged and there was a crown to be given to the champion's lady.

In between rounds of combat, there were songs, dancing (a pavane was performed), and a knighting. In History of the Kingdom of the West, the First Year, Master Wilhelm Schlussel (Bill Keyes) wrote, "As the other fighters were all styled as knights, and as David

the Herald was fighting well, Sir Siegfried von Hoflichskeit, with the consent of the rest of the fighters, called David forth to kneel and, in the manner of the medieval order of chivalry, dubbed him knight. This was the first knighting in the Society, giving David (now Ardral Argo verKaeysc) the title of First Knight."

The participants enjoyed themselves and decided to have another tournament. As so an idea born from research and study, spread across the U.S. and later the world. After reading these accounts of the origins of the SCA and the Kingdom of the West, I realize how much of our Society and the way we play the game is traced back to the beginning.

## Chronicler Position Open

Due to a pending move just outside of Atlantia into the East Kingdom in June of 2016, I will be stepping down as Baronial Chronicler this June (2015). I'll still be in the area, so can train and assist as needed. Below is a brief excerpt from Kingdom Law which includes links to Kingdom requirements for the office and the newsletter.

- —Serve a 2-year term; can be renewed at the end of each term for as long as Chronicler wishes.
- —Record minutes of monthly Baronial Business Meeting [held the 4th Sunday of each month, with the exception of December (holidays) and sometimes July (due to Pennsic)].
- —All Baronies in Atlantia are required to have a warranted Chronicler who is required to publish a monthly newsletter (required contents are outlined in Kingdom Law, item 6.11.9 (see "Kingdom Chronicler's Policies" link below)
- —Solicit articles, photos, artwork, and letters from Baronial Officers for inclusion in the newsletter (you don't have to write it all yourself!!!).
- —Complimentary electronic copies of each newsletter (in PDF form, NOT a link to a website) must be sent to Their Majesties, Their Highnesses (unless there are no Heirs in that month), Kingdom Seneschal, Kingdom Chronicler, Kingdom Historian, SCA Archivist, Baron & Baroness, Baronial Seneschal, Baronial Webmaster (for posting to Barony's website) and the Atlantian Chronicler's Group. Also posted on the Barony's Facebook page.
- —Newsletters are to be published NOT LATER THAN the 5th of the month they are for, however, it is encouraged that they are published no earlier than the 25th of the month prior, with an intent of the publication being available on the 1st.
- —The Chronicler must have permission from each Officer and Baronial Notable to publish that person's information in the newsletter (Editor's Note: it's currently upto-date).
- —All articles, photos, and artwork must be covered by a "Permission to Publish" form which can be found on the last page of *Il Tempo*. Information about what needs to be covered by a release form can be found at http://chronicler.atlantia.sca.org/ Releases.html. There is a list of "blanket" releases on file that is maintained by the Kingdom Release Deputy.

#### Seneschal—Christine Menton (Caitilin)
