What is a Noyon?

Looking to get in good with the new Noyon? Here's some useful info!

Noyon is a title of authority in the Mongol Empire and later periods.

Noyon, as a title, is suffixed to the name. So, instead of being prefixed like Baron, the term is added after the name. The appropriate reference would be Naran Noyon.

Our Noyon tells us that it's pronounced "noy – on" (like boy or toy).

"Your Noyon" doesn't quite work. Instead, use "yes, Noyon" or "O my Noyon" or "O Noyon."

However, if all that's too complicated to remember, you're probably still safe using "your Excellency". He *probably* won't have you punished.


