- ◆ *From Naran:*
- ◆ Not much. Some stuff for New Business.
- ◆ Did an MIT class for Sof'ia and Marion
- ◆ In theory, we expect to be opening up in June. There will be events to shoot at hopefully.
- ◆ Storvik Novice coming up. Max 50 people can go.
 - (MT) Send our champion for Archery? No archery at event.
- ◆ *From MT:*
- ◆ Not sure how things are going to open up. She just got her first shot.
- ◆ Still doing stuff online.
- ◆ Have been taking part in fiber challenge from Scholastica .
- ◆ Try and do heavy practice this upcoming weekend in May. Will attend as one of the two marshals.
- ◆ Online courts or online activities. Depends on what we are doing from week to week.
- ◆ Have some silverware potentially give away to Newcomers if anyone would like to take custody of them for Newcomer baskets. If things open up.
 - (Naran) also has some silver goblets for that same kind of purpose.

Events

June Virtual Court

- ◆ (MT) Not sure we should even have the June event. We have Bloodbath in July. If we have June court, then we will have nothing for July court. Only two awards to give out other than the A&S. Not that robust.
- ◆ (Adina) Simone was saying doesn't matter what the space/locality says...if we are still in Phase 0 or 1, we may not be able to hold Bloodbath.
- ◆ Will have to keep eyes on the splash page for Kingdom Events. Follow the COVID links. Phases keep changing.
 - Stierbach is closed as of the 22nd.
 - So is Suddentore. And Caer Maer.

- ◆ June Court will go forward then...
- ◆ Who pretape and cut the film?
- ◆ (Hakon) Push to July, and go with virtual if we can't do Bloodbath?
 - The conflict was university
 - Since Bloodbath is already spiked, we've got that date.
- ◆ So, don't do June Court. If we shut down, we'll just make Bloodbath a virtual event.
 - (Hakon) also give us more time to open up.
- ◆ Will plan the same sort of court for Bloodbath
- ◆ Would like to recognize some folks we don't see a lot of, that maybe we've seen. So please do pass recommendations to MT and Naran.

Bloodbath in July

- ◆ (Adina) Set up the page. Check with Marion. Irish vs. Vikings.
- ◆ Already up on Facebook. Need to get Ponte Alto website updated.
- ◆ Event based on the first viking invasion.
- ◆ Food will be prepackaged salty snacks. Stuff that folks open themselves. Water and Gatorade provided. Need to bring your own cups. We can provide sealed water. (Like bottled water.)
 - Hakon was also talking to Simone. We can do a 5 gallon container, but have to provide hand sanitizer. So, bottled water is a good alternative.
- ◆ If the weather is nice, and we're on the field, we can set up two areas. Definitely outside. Breezy. Next to basketball courts. Pop-ups encouraged. Limited staking area.
- ◆ According to state (in regards to expected quarantine guidelines), we should be able to do it.
- ◆ By reservation only. Have to pre-reg. Ok to pay at the gate. Keep the numbers down. Encourage the locals to participate.
- ◆ Avoid traveling great distances.
- ◆ Will need help to move the list fence.
 - Also, we will need a new chamberlain, since Hakon cannot be that and Seneschal.
- ◆ Trailer? Is full of Pennsic stuff. In Adina's driveway.
- ◆ Need one pick-up truck. Maybe a mini-van. Nothing especially long.

Wild Hunt

- ◆ (Marion) Still recommend we go virtual this year. Still no movement on the other events yet.

Old Business

- ◆ n/a

New Business

- ◆ (Marion) Based on recent Social Media recommendations. Proposing some changes to our Facebook group.
 - Change setting from Public to Private.
 - Page is still the official place to announce things.
 - Add better Security Questions for admission of new members. Right now questions are very vague and easy to get past. Ways to vet people who want to join as being a real person with real interest in the SCA. Examples: "What does the abbreviation "SCA" stand for?" "What local SCA group do you participate with?" "Do you have a persona/society name?" "What is your SCA name?" "Do you have any SCA-related/adjacent interests? If so what?" "How did you hear about the SCA?"
 - Two other recommendations: Include bullying and harassment rules and make those a requirement to agree to support them to join.
 - Function in FB that requires 30 day post moderation as a failsafe for new members.
 - Next problem, there are a lot of people on the admin list. 13 admins. 9 are not current officers. Seneschal, Web, SMO, Chatelain to keep. Will be weeding that down. (Seamus) We need enough to ensure they get responses. All the admins should be an active officer.
 - Will be putting together a list of all the links to the various groups. Rapier, Heavy (not specifically Ponte Alto), Cooking Guild. A&S. Pennsic Camp.
 - Discussion about adding the label "Unofficial". General agreement that changing group to private should alleviate this.
 - No objections, go ahead and do it.
- ◆ (Naran) Suggested doing some sort of camping thing around Pennsic time timeframe (since we can't do Pennsic).
- ◆ (MT) Pennsic Pity Party?
- ◆ Pennsic in the Backyard
- ◆ Discussion of Silver Lake. \$100 to pay for the porta-johns.
- ◆ (Adina) would be going way out of the area, which is against kingdom policy. Pick one group to play with, and stick with them.
- ◆ (Naran) something closer? Like Burke(?) Lake?
- ◆ (MT) not sure how we'd manage the numbers. That would be closer, and it is on our barony.

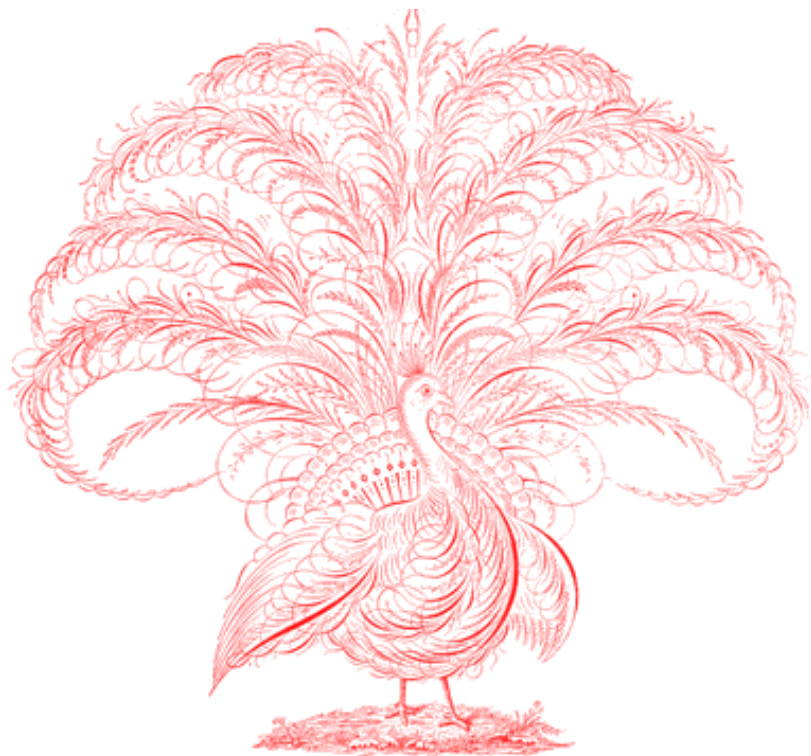
A&S Update from Marion Compton

Creating Leather Demi Gauntlets

Getting the leather wet (Veg Tan) allows it to be carved or pressed with images that will stay after it dries. Here I did something basic for a first outing on practical piece. The Star inset into the Diamond is the Restormel Household badge.

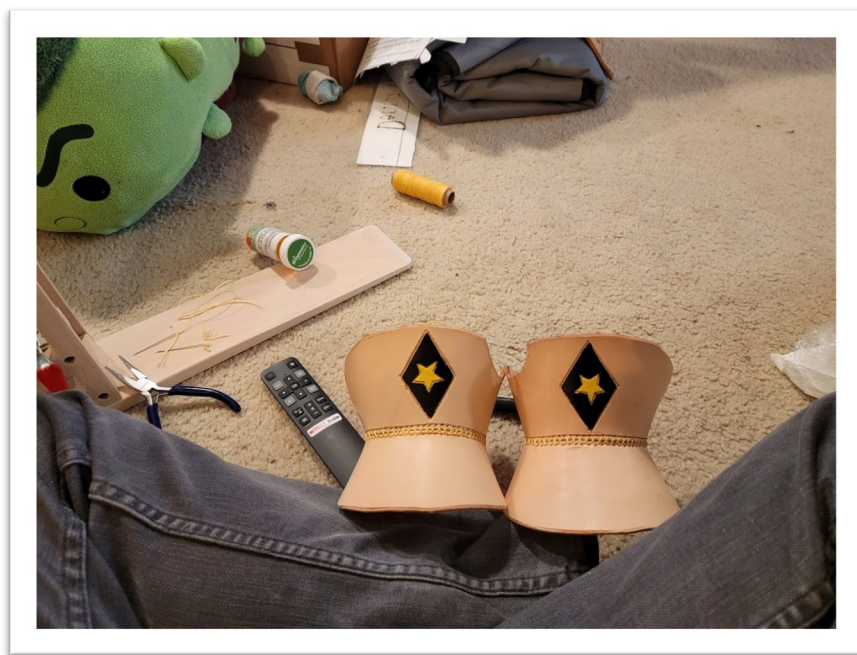
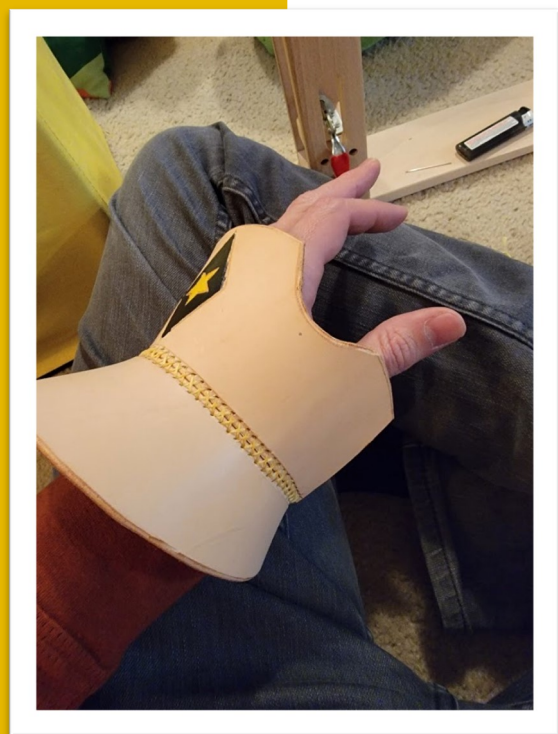


Feature Article (cont.)

After drying I applied an acrylic paint (for leather) to the leather to really help show off the badge.



I went with a lighter more natural colored wax thread, hoping it would contrast the darkened end product. Here are the pieces stitched together and assembled before the wax bath.

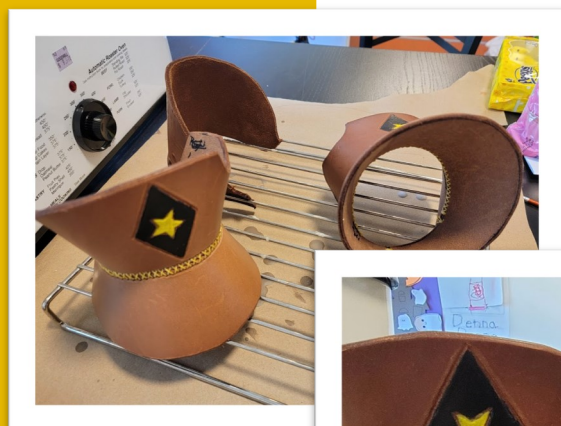


Feature Article (cont.)

Prepping the wax bath, this is paraffin wax (low melt temp). Items not shown in this photo fire extinguisher as a precaution. The bit of leather here is my test piece that is also what i had been practicing traditional tooling on.



Just pulled from the leather bath and some very basic shaping and adjusting (hot). As they cool and the wax firms and hardens the color of the leather also darkens and the changes can be seen in the next few images.

Martial Practice Update

OYEZ-OYEZ! REOPENING INFO!

Ponte Alto Martial Practices - Phase 0

When? **Sundays @ 12PM**

Where? **Mason District Park** in Annandale. **Armored and Rapier will be separated at different parts of the park until Phase 1. Specific locations on site TBD.**

How? **By reservation only**. See official Ponte Alto FB page (or Colette) for updates.

Who? **Adult martial participants. No spectators! No minors!**

Tips

Bring several masks as wet masks become unsafe and unusable. Prepare to **go slowly at first** as your body is unlikely to be properly conditioned for full speed fighting unless you've been drilling and practicing over the year-long break.

Restrictions

- Limited to 10 or fewer per gathering
- No minors are allowed
- No loaner armor can be given
- You can play with only one practice at this time - so choose and stick with it!
- Participants ONLY. No spectators can attend at this time.

Compliance

1. **Masks** are required at all times (even outdoors). You are responsible for bringing your own mask(s).
2. **Food & water** cannot be shared or given. You must bring your own and keep it with your things
3. **6' social distancing** with the exception of those who live together. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the practice.
4. **Inspections** in compliance with the SCA guidelines will occur at each practice and is the exception to the 6' distancing rule if necessary.
5. **Reservations** will be taken for each practice in order to keep to the required 10 person limit. You must reserve to say you are coming ahead of time or you will be turned away.

Sign in sheet & health screening for contact tracing will be required at each practice in order to assist local officials in the event one of our fighters contracts COVID-19

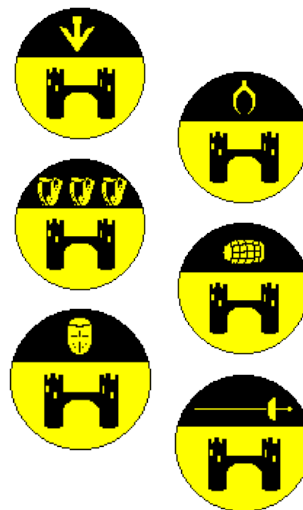

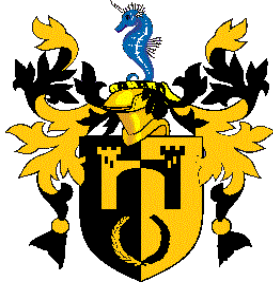
Who can retain?
