BLOODBATH PLANNING MINUTES

This meeting took place as an adjunct to our social hour, as a means to facilitate some Bloodbath planning.

- (Hakon) discussion of budget for Bloodbath, and modifications to the form for infrastructure cost, changes of policy, adding a line item for prizes.
- One line for site fee (if higher attendance, it will be a higher site cost) \$25
 -> \$75 + % of gate
- (Adina) discussion of the costs.
- Food budget stays as stands
- Already have tokens, but Adina bought some additional ones.
- (Adina) recounted the budget briefly. Expected fee \$10 per person. No children allowed as already published.
- Suggestion for a food truck. Briefly discussed.
- From Simone, everything pre-pay. We have a variance (for Bloodbath) to accept exact amount. Check or money order.
- Kingdom policy is still pre-reg required. (Even if SCA policy has changed.)
- (Marion) Do we have marshal staff? (Hakon) Earmarked. Not all confirmed. (Colette) I will take care of that.
- Discussion about adding line items. Will prepare another budget. Then another round of approvals from the emergency budget team.
- No Nays put forward.
- (Hakon) Additional changes expected July 1. Including mask policy. Cannot ask. So, it's on your honor.

- Trying to attend the practices to get them going.
- Talking about melees early on Sundays. With a quick orientation class beforehand.
- Call out for Largess. Got lots from Lisbet of the Spinning Winds. *Always* in need of Largess. Not just for the birthdays and stuff.
- ♦ From Naran:
- ◆ To attend: BB, Armistice, SBB, Battle on the Bay, Trial by Fire, WoW, Revenge of the Stitch possibly, and Holiday Faire



- ♦ Has been talking to folks for WoW. IF you are going to camp with us, register sooner rather than later. We are a legacy camp there. Some rights, but if you are facing the road. We have Honey Badger on the side, and they keep getting bigger. Meridies Royals also coming. To make sure we have enough room, register!
- Coronation went well. Their majesties called the Noyon insouciant.
- Relayed investiture gifts. Talked to their majesties.

Events

Bloodbath in July

- Sent out an updated spreadsheet. Additional line items added. Discussion of the form. Form was shared to the Zoom for discussion.
- Updates to some of the vocabulary. Plus \$5 for non-members. Estimated \$145 profit with 70 people at the gate. 83 currently registered.
- Any opposition? No. This is good, and we'll go forward.
- Any registrations at fighter practice? No. But did talk about fees.
- Initial emails sent out. Will send out more instructions for pre-paying. Exact change only at the gate. Encourage everyone to pre-pay.
- Bring drinking vessels and food for yourself.
- Wear masks if not vaccinated. Park does not require proof. Discussion.
- Make sure we get it published.
- ♦ Additional info for martial at Bloodbath? No, just beat-pit.
- Marion has been sending out stuff.
- Nothing in the ground. Can't use stakes at the site, except for one location. Allowed wll be: Royal Tent, Day-shade for troll, one other tent, that's all. Reviewed map with park authorities to get locations for staked tents. Have to avoid sprinkler system pipes.
- Still need to see if Chatelain will be able to attend. Not sure about loaner garb. (Hakon) We are allowed to provide Gold Key now. Ensure everything is washed. Try to bag each individual item. Also good to see what we have. (Adina) we have lots. Stored in 3 locations. Will follow up with Chatelain on Monday.
- Need to engage 2 pickup trucks to transport list fence.
- Need court herald. We have someone who is interested.
- Will reach out to the Duchess for Crown requirements.
- Will go shopping with someone to get water and snacks. Salty snacks in a bin. Tongs. Hand them out with site tokens.
- Planning on making a sable layer mask, black and gold for the staff. Light weight.
- No sharing of food or water.
- Can have water coolers.
- Can have cups.



- There will be sanitizer next to the coolers.
- Will be giving out bottled water.
- No porta-potty.
- Bear-pit for martial. Will check on what Rapier wants to do. (Colette says there will not be a BlackSword. Not until late Aug/early Sep. Awaiting info from Rapier marshal for the day.)
- (Hakon) will check with folks on the heat index/weather rules.
- Will have rosters to send out. Want to capture membership numbers.
- Need waivers for the non-members.
- Will work with Marion to put together current list. Will send out posters.
- Will get Ponte Alto stand up signs.
- Crown will use our chairs, unless they tell us otherwise.
- (MT) We'll use our own chairs.
- Kingdom banner? (MT) We used to have one. It got mistakenly claimed.
 Will work on something. Even if just colored banners. Discussion of how to display.
- (Adina) bring a back wall? Yes, will bring.
- (Hakon) let's set up a logistics meeting for that. We're down in the weeds. Need 2 trucks and help to move fences from storage shed. Have tents, tables, etc. accounted for.

- (Marion) recently moved. FFX public schools are opening up for renting space. Would like to (if barony amenable) reserve space/site for Kingdom A&S Festival.
- (MT) Do we have the people to pull this off? (Marion) We will.
- Confident if we got the bid, we can pull it off.

- (MT) Give up Bloodbath to do this? (Marion) I don't know.
- (Adina) Spring Crown? There's already someone planning to do it.
- (MT) Would like to do L&B again.

- (MT) Baronial Birthday, Kingdom A&S, and Bloodbath, then we can't do anything else until fall. That's a lot in a short timeframe. Think about what we want to do, and towards the end of the year.

Helm Crafting

Article by Hákon brimill

Drawings and concepts to work from, based on Gjermundbu helm with ideas for making it SCA heavy fighting legal. Master Baschamp-Paul Montargent allowed me to help in the build process and teach me some of the basics of helmet assembly. The bulk of the work was done by his hand, with me either lending assist or being taught techniques along the way. These techniques included cold raising of the 12g stainless that makes up the structure of the helm, welding (although all stainless welds were performed by B.P.). Drilling, riveting etc were often a team effort but not all done together. The 3 dimensional work (crest and eyebrows) were carved by B.P. The flat brass work was designed and etched by me using modern methods and then all polished to the results shown here.


