PONTE ALTO PROFILES

Getting to know Baron Hákon and Baroness Hrefna



== Hákon brimill ==

Who are you? (SCA name, title, etc)

Sir Hákon brimill, Baron of Ponte Alto - brimill is a byname that basically means big seal (like the animal)

How did you find the SCA?

I actually was introduced to the SCA a few times without ever really realizing what it was until the third time, that really stuck. I was talking with Heinrich and he was telling me about this group of people who were sword fighting in the park behind my in-laws apartment. One Sunday afternoon I popped out when we were visiting and watched and talked with some folks. I did this for a while and started thinking how I would very much like to give this a try. One of the fighters who was much smaller than I was, offered me up his armor and helm and let me try.

By the time I got back up to the apartment for dinner, I was a disheveled mess. Bruised, exhausted and grinning like a fool. I don't recall exactly what Hrefna said as she saw Heinrich and I walking inside, but it was something to the effect of "Oh gods, how much is this going to cost". I did not know much beyond fighting in the park for a fair bit of time. Which really leads to the follow up question.

What was your first event?

It was a Tournament of Love and Beauty, hosted by Ponte Alto. It was in a barn out in Leesburg and I was by myself as Hrefna gave me leave to attend the event while she stayed home to tend to the littles. That was the event that I authorized at and met so many new people, some of whom would become amazingly dear friends in the following years. I had no idea what was going on for most of the day but sure was glad to be included.

What hooked you?

I'd like to say it was the fighting and only that, but really that would not be true. I think the moment I realized that I had found a place to hang out and be around a lot of people like me was helping setup for a Crown Tournament. We got together on a Friday afternoon (Ironically at the same site as my first event). I was just one instrument in a concert helping make setup go faster and ensure everything would be ready for the following day. I think that would really have been my AH HA moment.

Tell us about your personas.

So I am mostly based on a 9/10c baltic scandinavian trader. He normally hails from the Uppsala region of Sweden. Hákon would trade mostly around the Baltic coast as well as the Isle of Gotland. With the occasional sojourn down the rivers in territory that we generically think of as Rus.

Do you have a favorite memory or story from any event you'd like to share, that hooked you?

I have a lot of "favorite moments" and stories. I honestly don't think there is an event I have attended where I have not come away with a special moment. I think though if I do pick just one (and it's hard). It would actually have been from this past 12th night. I happened to grab an award medallion (Sharks Tooth) as we were packing (I normally do not wear them) to head to the venue. Then I decided at the last minute to wear it, for some reason. As we were all gathered and talking and sharing stories as the day progressed, I found myself in conversation talking about the previous Pennsic and had made a comment about how awesome the combat archers were on the field. I then listened and discovered that the good Noble I was talking with was one of those archers but had not received a physical medallion as the Combat Archers had been granted the Sharks Tooth as a group. I recall how over the moon I was when I was given my first and realized why I had worn the medallion that day. It turns out, I had just been hanging onto it till it found its proper owner. I took it off and handed over the medallion and was thrilled to see it being worn by the very same Noble at our Investiture.

What advice would you offer to someone just getting started in the SCA?

Take lots of small bites of any and all activities you find of interest. Enjoy and savor the moment of each activity as you learn what you like and don't like. Don't be afraid to put something down and realize it was not for you. Also, embrace your inner weirdness; it makes the journey so much more fun.

== Hrefna blinda ==

Who are you? (SCA name, title, etc)

Lady Hrefna blinda - blinda is a byname that means blind, when I finally settled on the name it was in a sort of low time during the plague where I had just managed to survive a near blinding set of infections.

How did you find the SCA?

Hákon really wanted to go to Pennsic, and started having me meet people. Next thing you know... I was in.

What was your first event?

It was a Storvik Novice Tournament. The day was going really well, until we discovered that the children DEFINITELY had a time limit for events at that point. That was the first time I did archery and Ronan* got a chance to try and shoot a very small bow that day.

Tell us about your personas.

Generic 9/10th century Norse Lady who has vision issues.

Do you have a favorite memory or story from any event you'd like to share?

Yes, it was our first Pennsic, it was very hot and humid and my first time camping, I was also very grumpy. Hákon had been off fighting and I was frustrated, I was talking to some folks in our camp and learned about the concept of mercenaries. Then subsequently hired a mercenary group to basically kill Hákon the next day on the battlefield. When he got back to camp after fighting and relayed how he felt like he was being targeted by archers to an extreme degree I realized how successful my mission was. My mood improved dramatically and I sorta fell in love with the SCA then.

What advice would you offer to someone just getting started in the SCA?

Take it slow, you don't have to rush into everything. Get to know the people, they are what make the SCA so awesome.



== Combined ==

When you joined, did you imagine ever stepping up as Baron & Baroness?

Nope, not once. It was not until after being a Seneschal for a while that I ever really understood the role. Then after some conversations with friends and family we decided we should give it some serious thought.

What ambitions or plans do you have for your reign?

I think first and foremost, continuing to build and grow the population of Ponte Alto and strengthen the foundations in the process. One of the ways we hope to do this is by finding ways to present information in a very newcomer friendly way.

We also want to try and streamline some of the processes and management of baronial operations and leverage technology where we can in support of these activities. In this venture we hope to merge some of the more traditional methods with new methods.

The last part is finding a way to help people volunteer and do jobs within the Barony and SCA as a whole without feeling over extended or causing burn out. We have also been talking with our Cousins and are coming up with ways to encourage cross-baronial support and more general event support attendance.
