Announcements

- Viscountess Katya ran a large table at Holiday Fair to raise funds for Ponte Alto's treasury. Thanks to the assistance of Lady Emilia di Castro, m'lord Arthur, Lord Tristan de Roquelaire, m'lord Mateo, and of course, Baron Hákon, we were able to get all kinds of things to the site and back to storage, selling about \$500 worth of Baronial Property that is no longer in use.
- Lord Robin has some fighting-related items that will be distributed at Fighter Practice for use by the fighters. Look for him.
- His Excellency has agreed to have one Sunday monthly when he will be available for consultation. He will attend practice, but plan not to fight, so that members of the populace who wish to speak to him about business things outside of the business meetings can do so. He wants to hear from you, so please take advantage. His first Open Chair Sunday will be at the Newcomer's Picnic on November 14th.

Katya is organizing some fabric projects to use up the donated fabric.

1. There will be a banner class at Thursday Fighter Practice one evening soon. It may be held over two nights to cover all the material we hope to have. She asks for the populace to bring in any banners or other heraldic representations to show students how we display heraldry.

2. Fabric has been provided to the Rapier Marshal who is making several loaner coats for new fighters.

3. The Gold Key, where we have all the loaner garb for visitors, is in need of some average-sized T-Tunics for both men and women. A project night is being planned for folks to bring sewing machines to practice and have a T-Tunic party. They are easy and don't take long, and we should be able to make several out of the donated fabric we currently have. Plus, folks who need their own T-Tunics can come and make some in a group and get help! (I know I need it!)

4. Scroll Cases – because these are always needed for Their Excellencies, and at Kingdom and one of our southern brethren (Barony) is desperate for them, any left-over fabric will be distributed to those who would like to volunteer to make some scroll cases. There was a class last year on this, but another can be held if there is enough interest.

5. In addition, several of our talented Pontoons know how to make Pennants. These are the long, silk, painted banners that fly beautifully from Pavilion poles. We are planning a Spring banner class on painting silk banners/pennants. If you don't have heraldry that you want to use, we will want to make some Baronial Banners that contain work from the entire populace.

- Archery will be held THIS Sunday (11/24) at Grimmsfield starting at 1:00pm. Additional Sunday/holiday practices will be scheduled through the winter months as weather allows.


through Facebook and other social media channels. For November, Grimmsfield will hold practice on Sunday the 24th.

We have decorated our homes with wreaths and greenery, and we take time to celebrate. The day is known for giving gifts, especially small tokens such as clay or wax figures known as sigilla, where this day gets its name.
