OFFICER'S REPORTS

Seneschal – Lord Rónán mac Imair (Ron Hanagan)

Curia is scheduled for September 4th at 3:00 PM. A post will be made on the "Atlantia Announcements" Facebook group.

The barony's zip code is being changed to align with the official Ponte Alto territory.

Knight Marshal - Miriam Giantslayer (Amanda Petritsch)

The last practice had a great turnout with 52 newcomers!

The group is looking for larger indoor spaces for the fall and winter seasons to accommodate both heavy and rapier fighting, as well as Arts & Sciences (A&S).

A local high school has expressed interest in a demonstration, and the necessary documentation will be sent to them.

The group is considering a shield-making or armoring day to help new fighters with their equipment.

Fabian, the Herald, noted that the barony does not have loaner helmets, which are needed for new fighters. The barony is considering a motion to purchase them.

There is also a discussion about a better storage solution for loaner gear from various members. The idea of combining with kingdom-level storage was proposed by Aaron.

Chatelaine – Lady Emilia di Nicastro (Maura Nicastle)

Maura is looking to create a dedicated Gold Key station with its own canopy, tarp changing room, and table.

A proposal for a budget of under \$200 for a full kit will be put together.

A target completion date for the kit is the end of the October event.

Pennsic 52 Armored Battle Recap

Atlantia had the opportunity to participate in this year's Pennsic War as a co-principal kingdom with Æthelmearc. This happened because the East Kingdom and Middle Kingdom, the main principal kingdoms at Pennsic, decided to ally together, making this the first "purple" Pennsic since 2017. The reason it is called a "purple" Pennsic is because the East is historically the "blue" side and the Midrealm is historically the "red" side, so when these 2 kingdoms ally together, red and blue combined make purple.

While Atlantia, Æthelmearc and the rest of the "green" team did not win the overall war points, Atlantia shined on the armored fighting field in a number of ways:

• Atlantia sustained its reputation in the Allied Champions-Capture the Flag Battle, which I recently learned is nicknamed "Atlantian Football" in other kingdoms. Our side won the battle 9-2, with HRM himself Abran de la Barra capturing one of the flags:

• The Atlantian Unbelted 10-Warrior Team went undefeated, which secured not only its 4th win in a row, but helped win the war point for the green side. This was the first time that the 10-Warrior tournament, which Atlantia hosts annually, was designated as a war point. We'll see if this continues in future Pennsics:

- Atlantia did its job and more in the Bridge Battle. Although our side didn't win the bridges, we maintained our bridge and lent our prowess to other bridges.
- The City Attack Battle was an experimental scenario that Atlantia had a hand in creating. Although our side didn't win the City Attack Battle, many people said it was their favorite armored battle of war with tough fighting and an opportunity to implement unique strategies.
- Atlantia performed excellently in the Field Battle, holding its position at the north part of the field near the castle wall for all 5 bouts.

While the Woods Battle was frustrating, it was extremely hard fought. Atlantia suffered losses in both the Unbelted and Belted Champions Battles, but participation in these battles was a great opportunity that Atlantia normally does not get as these are typically limited to East and Mid fighters only. Atlantians also had higher-than-usual participation in the Heroics Champions battles by virtue of being a co-principal Kingdom. Several Ponties received awards for fighting at Pennsic. Forannán and Tegan both received shark's teeth. Jacques Gonse and Tegan received the King's Award of Excellence for command. Many Ponties received awards in other disciplines, such as rapier, service, and arts and sciences. Our own Anauved was elevated to Laurel and Naran was elevated to the Mark. Forgiveness for missing other notable awards!

Being a part of all of the behind-the-scenes coordination that happens at Pennsic gives me a new appreciation for the effort that goes into the event by scores of volunteers. Thank you to the hay bale movers, marshal staff, MOL team and all of the others who bring this event together.

Finally, I cannot forget to mention that Ponte Alto's own Bailey of Anglesey fought in all of the youth battles! Someone find me my shades, because the future is bright!
