Taking the Oath

Rónán's Elevation to the Order of the Mark 6 September 2025

To say I was caught off guard was an understatement. I ventured south to attend the Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday event with the intention of celebrating the elevation of Lorelei Greenleafe to the **Order of the Mark**. After **Mistress Lorelei Greenleafe** was called into court by **King Abran**, and gave her oath to the kingdom, I was called into court to be asked if it was my desire to join this same Order.

Nor was I expecting to be invited to join this Order so soon. I thought there were many worthy individuals who would get inducted before I would be considered.

After court, I was whisked away by Master Stephan Grimm and Lord Torin of Mildenhalle, who escorted me back to our camp, and kept me under guard, where I awaited his majesty to visit.

When his majesty arrived, several folks were invited to speak on my behalf.

Including:

Sir Hákon brimill speaking for the Chivalry
Duchess Lynette Semre for the Rose
Mistress Lorelei Greenleafe for the Laurel
Master Stephan Grimm for the Pelican
Master Celestria Alexandre d'Amiens for the MOD
and finally Master Miles de Locwode for the Mark

I can't remember all of their words, but I can remember the feeling in my heart as they each spoke, and that was humbled.

A couple of the speakers were kind enough to send me a copy of their words, and I wanted to share them here because of how deeply they touched me.

"The Silence of Ronan" Sir Hákon brimill

Ronan can be quiet, but his silence carries further than many men's boasts. He carries a calm certainty, as a shadow amongst the trees, his gaze as sharp as tip of an arrow. When his bow bends, shafts fly as though guided by his will alone;

When axe leaves his grasp, the mark has little hope of escape. His art is not thunderous, but sure and steady, as a great tree that weathers every calamity.

Although his prowess does mark him, it is the manner in which he shares it. He guides and teaches with measured words and a bottomless well of patience. Those whom he has worked with often gain more than just skill, they often get to carry a part of his quiet strength and focus.

He is strong of duty, steadfast of character, but asks for no praise. Yet his worthiness is seen in the flight of every shaft, the cast of each axe, students and friends who walk taller for his counsel. He truly does leave a mark on all those that surround him.

There is a saying that rings true on all fields: Steel sharpens steel. That is to say, those with exceptional skill will bring up those around them. Yet oftentimes, when Chris, Torin, or I would arrive at a competition, Ronan would comment that one of us would win the day and say nothing of himself.

Despite what he may or may not say, Ronan does have prowess underneath his cloak of humility; I have seen it when he made the quarterfinals of Royal Archer -- advancing further than I did that day. I have seen it in his long-distance shooting and axe-throwing victories, and in the times I've had to redraw our thrown weapons target because he destroyed the center.

And it is not just through prowess that Ronan uplifts others;

If I tried to keep track of all the times he encouraged people to come to practice, or pointed out a change in my form, or invited others to the Pennsic range -- for setup, to marshal, to shoot war points -- then I would lose count, much like the countless arrows I've ever loosed.

If Ronan considers me to be fierce competition, it is largely because he helped me reach that level by being fierce competition himself, and from the way he fosters spaces in which we can challenge each other, learn, and grow.

For all of this and more, he is my peer.
