Hallowed Market Event Steward's Report

The Barony of Ponte Alto in partnership with Mountain Run Winery hosted a hybrid medieval history demonstration and market event on 25 October. Demonstrations included thrown weapons, archery, blacksmithing, book binding and scribe work, glass bead making, nallbinding, youth combat, dancing, and heraldry. The market included several vendors including Badger Bronze Works, Badass Garb, Josh Haller Knives, Black Wing Norse Designs, Magdalena's Delights Perfume, Alexis Keyes Jewelry, and Katharine Ravenhill.

The event attracted over 500 participants including nearly 450 members of the public, most of whom had never heard of the SCA.

Several of these new public contacts opted to pay the fee for the SCA Hallowed Market event that followed the public demonstration. SCA veterans and newcomers alike enjoyed delicious food prepared by the Artemesian chef, Connor of Sentinel's Keep, who delighted all with his sumptuous beef stew, pulled pork, beef brisket, and pork ribs, all prepared over camp fires.

After enjoying the delicious food, many revelers remained on site, enjoying the warm hospitality of Mountain Run Winery's Greenlee Tavern. The revelry and song continued through the night and into the early morning hours before folk retired to their tents to get a few hours of sleep in the crisp autumn air.

The success of this hybrid event in reaching members of the public and attracting new potential members holds promise for continued community building and growth across northern Atlantia. Conversations are already underway in Ponte Alto and with other potential baronial partners on another hybrid event for next year.
